PURPOSE The Sayreville Police Department endorses the secure use of social media to enhance communication, collaboration, and information exchange; streamline processes; and foster productivity. This policy establishes this department's position on the utility and management of social media and provides guidance on its management, administration, and oversight. This policy is not meant to address one particular form of social media; rather social media in general, as advances in technology will occur and new tools will emerge.

POLICY Social media provides a new and potentially valuable means of assisting the department and its personnel in meeting community outreach, problem-solving, investigative, crime prevention, and related objectives. This policy identifies potential uses that may be explored or expanded upon as deemed reasonable by administrative and supervisory personnel. The department also recognizes the role that these tools play in the personal lives of some department personnel. The personal use of social media can have bearing on departmental personnel in their official capacity. As such, this policy provides information of a precautionary nature as well as prohibitions on the use of social media by department personnel

PROCEDURES

I. General

A. Definitions:

1. Avatar – A computer user's representation of himself/herself or an alter ego.
2. Blog – A series of electronic entries, diary or commentary, written by one or more persons in an on-line journal that may permit visitors to post responses, reactions or comments. The term is an abbreviated version of 'web-log'.
3. Comments – Responses to a blog post, news article, social media entry or other social networking post.
4. Commenting – The act of creating and posting a response to a blog post, news article, social media entry or other social networking post. Commenting can also entail the act of posting an original composition to an unrelated post or article.
5. Forum – An online discussion site.
6. Identity – An online identity, Internet identity or Internet persona that a social networking user establishes. This can be a real name, an alias, a pseudonym or a creative description.
7. Mobile Social Networking – Social networking using a mobile phone or other cellular based device.
8. Page – The specific portion of a social media website where content is displayed, and managed by an individual or individuals with administrator rights.
9. Post – The content a person shares on a social media site or blog; an entry to any type of computerized bulletin board; the act of publishing content on a social media site.
10. Posting – The act of creating, uploading, editing or adding to any social media outlet. This includes text, photographs, audio, video or any other multimedia file.
11. Profile – Information that a user provides about himself or herself on a social networking site.
12. Social Media – A category of Internet-based resources that integrate user-generated content that allow people to communicate, share information, share photos, share videos, share audio and exchange text and other multimedia files with others via some form of online or cellular network platform. This includes, but is not limited to, social networking sites (Facebook®, MySpace®), micro-blogging sites (Twitter®), photo- and video-

sharing sites (Flickr®, YouTube®), wikis (Wikipedia®), blogs, and news sites (Digg®, Reddit®).

13. Social Networks – Online platforms where users can create profiles, share information, and socialize with others using a range of technologies.
14. Speech – Expression or communication of thoughts or opinions in spoken words, in writing, by expressive conduct, symbolism, photographs, videotape, or related forms of communication.
15. Web 2.0 – The second generation of the World Wide Web focused on shareable, user-generated content, rather than static web pages. Some use this term interchangeably with social media.
16. Wiki – Web page(s) that can be edited collaboratively. Post: an item inserted to a blog or an entry to any type of computerized bulletin board or forum.

II. On-The-Job-Use

A. Department-Sanctioned Presence

1. Determine Strategy
 - a. Where possible, each social media page shall include an introductory statement that clearly specifies the purpose and scope of the agency's presence on the website.
 - b. Where possible, the page(s) should link to the department's official website.
 - c. Social media page(s) shall be designed for the target audience(s) such as youth or potential police recruits.
2. Procedures
 - a. All department social media sites or pages shall be approved by the Chief of Police or his or her designee and shall be administered by the departmental information services section or as otherwise determined.
 - b. Where possible, social media pages shall clearly indicate they are maintained by the department and shall have department contact information prominently displayed.
 - c. Social media content shall adhere to applicable laws, regulations, and policies, including all information technology and records management policies.
 - 1) Content is subject to public records laws. Relevant records retention schedules apply to social media content.

- 2) Content must be managed, stored, and retrieved to comply with open records laws and e-discovery laws and policies.

d. Where possible, social media pages should state that the opinions expressed by visitors to the page(s) do not reflect the opinions of the department.

- 1) Pages shall clearly indicate that posted comments will be monitored and that the department reserves the right to remove obscenities, off-topic comments, and personal attacks.

- 2) Pages shall clearly indicate that any content posted or submitted for posting is subject to public disclosure.

3. Department-Sanctioned Use

a. Department personnel representing the department via social media outlets shall do the following:

- 1) Conduct themselves at all times as representatives of the department and, accordingly, shall adhere to all department standards of conduct and observe conventionally accepted protocols and proper decorum;

- 2) Identify themselves as a member of the department;

- 3) Not make statements about the guilt or innocence of any suspect or arrestee, or comments concerning pending prosecutions, nor post, transmit, or otherwise disseminate confidential information, including photographs or videos, related to department training, activities, or work-related assignments without express written permission;

- 4) Not conduct political activities or private business.

b. The use of department computers by department personnel to access social media is prohibited without authorization.

c. Department personnel use of personally owned devices to manage the department's social media activities or in the course of official duties is prohibited without expressed written permission.

d. Employees shall observe and abide by all copyright, trademark, and service mark restrictions in posting materials to electronic media.

B. Potential Uses

1. Social media is a valuable investigative tool when seeking evidence or information about:

a. Missing persons;

- b. Wanted persons;
 - c. Gang participation;
 - d. Crimes perpetrated online (i.e. cyber-bullying, cyber-stalking);
 - e. Photos or videos of a crime posted by a participant or observer.
2. Social media can be used for community outreach and engagement by:
- a. Providing crime prevention tips;
 - b. Offering online-reporting opportunities;
 - c. Sharing crime maps and data;
 - d. Soliciting tips about unsolved crimes (i.e. Crime-stoppers, text-a-tip).
3. Social media can be used to make time-sensitive notifications related to:
- a. Road closures;
 - b. Special events;
 - c. Weather emergencies;
 - d. Missing or endangered persons.
4. Persons seeking employment and volunteer positions use the Internet to search for opportunities, and social media can be a valuable recruitment mechanism.
5. This department has an obligation to include Internet-based content when conducting background investigations of job candidates.
6. Internet-based searches should be conducted by a non-decision maker. Information pertaining to protected classes shall be filtered out prior to sharing any information found online with decision makers.
7. Persons authorized to search Internet-based content should be deemed as holding a sensitive position.
8. Search methods shall not involve techniques that are a violation of existing law.
9. Vetting techniques shall be applied uniformly to all candidates.
10. Every effort must be made to validate Internet-based information considered during the hiring process.

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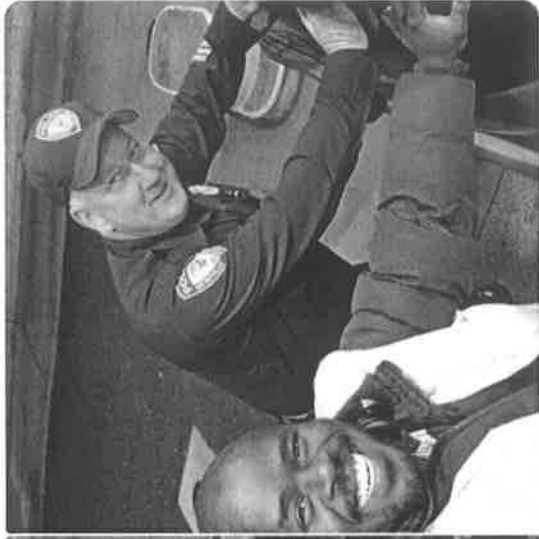
