POINT PLEASANT BEACH TO ELIMINATE PLASTIC BAGS

Point Pleasant Beach, April 30, 2018 – At a Council Meeting Tuesday night, the Point Pleasant Beach Council will propose an ordinance to eliminate single use plastic bags from the town, joining Long Beach Island in taking this initiative to improve the environment.

The mayor, council and environmental commission members have been working together on how to implement this for Point Pleasant Beach. They felt now was the right time to make this happen.

"Eliminating plastic bags will make Point Pleasant Beach a better town," said

Mayor Stephen Reid. "With three lakes, the inlet and ocean, plastic bags in our water ways cause a hazard to the birds, marine life and pets making their homes here."

According to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") in 2016, as many as 1 trillion plastic bags are used worldwide each year and an estimated less than 5% of that plastic is recycled; and in the United States alone, according to the EPA, over 380 billion plastic bags and wraps are used each year, approximately 40% of the bags used are single-use plastic bags. Exceptions under this proposed ordinance would include: plastic bags used for bait; those used to store produce, meats, frozen and deli foods and flowers; those used by pet stores to tote live fish; dry cleaner and door hangar bags; and those sold in packages, such as garbage liners and pet-waste bags. Also, food-assistance programs will be exempt and permitted to use plastic bags to carry food items and meals.

Businesses would not have to eliminate bags right away. They can use up their inventory of plastic bags until they run out before they are in violation. Point Pleasant Beach has purchased 1,000 reusable canvas bags which will be made available to Point Pleasant Beach residents.

"We are going to be able to accomplish this without taxing any of our residents and businesses," noted Mayor Reid. "We have used the same language from the Long Beach ordinances and have worked closely with the Chamber and business owners as well as receiving great input from environmental groups throughout the state in coming to the conclusions we
