Anyone can drive in the parking lot at any time of the day. They would be "sitting ducks". Is there any plan in place to evacuate children from the playground in the case of a shooter? Who would be responsible to get them to safety? Where could they run? There is no shelter in place if you are outside with no place to hide or go and no one preventing access to the playground. This needs to be addressed immediately.

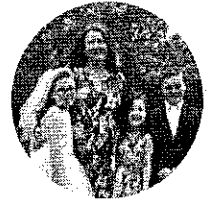

Mayor Ducey met with the Police Chief the day directly after the tragedy to discuss safety and how the schools are prepared. The Chief, along with other officers, have met with school personnel and come up with very specific plans regarding school safety. In addition to what was already in place. Some of these highlights are below:

- The police department has always had a concern for the safety of the children in our schools and to that end have had security and training measures in place for years.
- All officers are equipped with swipe cards which allow officers immediate access to all schools eliminating the need to be buzzed in
- Officers are required to conduct a check and walk through of schools in their respective district at least twice a shift.
- Regular police officers (School Resource Officers) are in both high schools and make periodic checks of the other schools throughout the day.
- Officers who administer programs such as DARE, Not Even Once and Lead & Seed are in the schools most of the school day most of the week from September through May
- Officers conduct annual active shooter drills using actors and simunitions equipment.
- Safety drills are conducted throughout the year with teachers and students and teachers receive additional training administered by our SRC's
- With the assistance of our department psychologist we will be training our officers who in turn will train our students and teachers in how to identify individuals who may be prone to violence
- We are setting up a means for teachers and students to anonymously report individuals who exhibit suspicious behavior
- We are working with the schools to arm those retired officers who are currently working in the schools
- We are working toward the hiring of Class II and/or Class III specials who will be armed and stationed in the schools
- The school is using monies which had been earmarked for parking lot paving to harden the entrances to several schools
- The schools will be putting on retainer a psychologist to expedite the process of getting a potentially troubled student evaluated and/or treatment
- The schools will be hiring a consultant to perform a security assessment and make recommendations to enhance security even further

- All plans will be continually evaluated and amended as necessary

If you're gonna plow the streets how about both sides from curb to curb. Not one side right up to the curb and the other side 5 or 6 feet out from the curb leaving a 5/6 foot wall from owners driveways to get into the street!

The plows do one pass on all streets to open a lane: then when all streets have a lane open they begin clearing whole streets. It is still early in the process. Plowing typically continued for 12 hours or more after snow falls depending on the storm.

That doesn't happen on my street and never has. The other side is plowed right to the curb and the other side never i mean never get plowed to the curb and we are always digging out from 5/6 foot walls that are plowed against the other side of the street every time it snows and the plow never plows to the curb on my side always 5/6 feet away creating wall that's 4 feet high and 6 feet wide. Come by and check it out for yourself, people are getting really pissed
