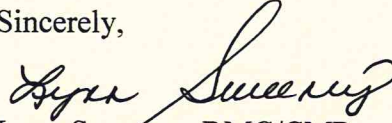
Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

1. A copy of policies and/or procedures regulating the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department public facebook page, any and all Wildwood, Ventnor, and Brigantine Police Department's policies regarding the maintenance and/or content retention of township maintained social media forums.
2. List(s) of names of people who are/were hidden, blocked, banned from the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's public facebook page.
3. List(s) of any deleted, hidden, blocked, banned comments that were on the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's Office's public facebook page for the time period of 1-1-2018 to 7-1-2019.
4. List(s) of the authors' names of any deleted, hidden, blocked, banned comments that were on the Wildwood, Ventnor, and Brigantine public facebook page for the time period of 1-1-2018 to 7-1-2019.
5. Copies of all messages and author's names sent via the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's facebook messenger and responses for the time period of 1-1-2018 to 7-1-2019.
6. Name and rank and/or position title of the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department employee(s) responsible for maintaining any and all Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's social media forums.
7. Any emails sent to/from the employee(s) in question regarding the deleting/removing of content, or the limiting of access to content on any and all social media forums for the time period of 1-1-2018 to 7-1-2019.

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill because of the size of the request. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time until July 30, 2019.
