Re: July 5, 2019 OPRA Request

Dear Anonymous:

The City of Brigantine (hereinafter "City") received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request dated July 5, 2019. The official Records Custodian, Lynn Sweeney, received your OPRA request on July 5, 2019. On July 16, 2019, the City requested additional time to fulfil the request pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. This response to your request is being provided to you within the additional time requested on July 16, 2019.

The City responds to requests 1, 2, 6 and 7 as follows:

1. **A copy of policies and/or procedures regulating the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department public facebook page, any and all Wildwood, Ventnor, and Brigantine Police Department's policies regarding the maintenance and/or content retention of township maintained social media forums.**

Response: No responsive documents.

2. **List(s) of names of people who are/were hidden, blocked, banned from the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's public facebook page.**

Response: The request is invalid under OPRA because it fails to reasonably specify identifiable government records and constitutes an overbroad and unclear request that would require the Custodian to conduct research outside the scope of her duties pursuant to MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverages Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534 (App. Div. 2005).

Subject to and without waiving the above objection, see attached document.

6. **Name and rank and/or position title of the Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department employee(s) responsible for maintaining any and all Wildwood, Ventnor, Brigantine Police Department's social media forums.**

Response: The request is invalid under OPRA because it fails to reasonably specify identifiable government records and constitutes an overbroad and unclear request that would require the Custodian to conduct research outside the scope of

her duties pursuant to MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverages Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534 (App. Div. 2005).

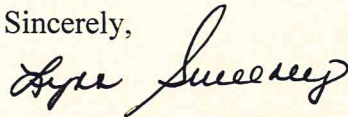

7. **Any emails sent to/from the employee(s) in question regarding the deleting/removing of content, or the limiting of access to content on any and all social media forums for the time period of 1-1-2018 to 7-1-2019.**

Response: No responsive documents.

Requests 3, 4 and 5 require additional time beyond July 30, 2019 because they require technical expertise to locate and the size of the request. The City has retained an IT consultant to assist in locating and obtaining any records responsive to these requests. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i, the City is requesting an extension of time until August 13, 2019.
