Good afternoon,

The Wall Township Board of Education is in receipt of your emailed request of December 16, 2025, wherein you requested records as follows:

“Records requested:

All records related to Facilities Department Tool Purchase(s) in the 2025 calendar year. This includes solicitation of bids, Invoices, Requisition Requests, Purchase Orders, and any other correspondence or inquiry related to this matter.”

Please be advised that to the extent that you have not identified a specific record, we deem your request to be overly broad. Please see *MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcohol Beverage Control*, 375 N.J. Super. 534 (App.Div. 2005). The custodian is not required to research files to determine which records, if any, might be responsive to a broad and unclear OPRA request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Wall Township Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, be-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
