The Edison Board of Education is in receipt of your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) dated November 20, 2019. We received your OPRA request on November 21, 2019. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is December 2, 2019. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 2nd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

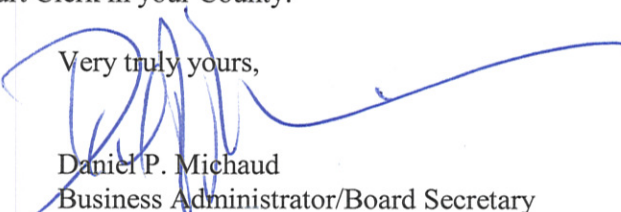
Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

1. Copy of total amount to Wilentz, Goldman and Spitzer for bond referendum [sic] counsel.
2. Copy of total amount paid to Scarini [sic] and Hollenbeck for bond related costs.
3. Copy of current expenditures paid to scarini [sic] and hollenbeck for attorney Ramon Rivera.
4. Total cost of bond referendum after interest.

Currently, your request is overly broad and fails to identify with reasonable clarity the specific government records sought. Bent v. Stafford Police Department, 381 N.J. Super. 30, 37 (App. Div. 2005). At this time, we request clarification of your OPRA request. Please respond in writing and identify the specific government records sought so that we may process your request. Failure to provide written clarification of your request will result in the closure of this OPRA request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Edison Board of Education to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
