Narrative:

Newton Fire Department was dispatched to 36 Mount View Street Apt. B for the reported structure fire. Dispatched said all residents were out. Pd confirmed smoke coming from the back apt. 810 arrived on scene to a 1.5 story 2 family home with smoke showing from the rear apt door upgrading it to a working fire assignment. 810 met with patrol who were using a garden hose through the door. Patrol stated they believed it was a stove fire that may have spread. Squad 3 arrived on scene followed by Engine 1. Squad 3 established a hydrant connection and 1.75" attack line was placed into service. Engine 1 was connected to squad 3 as a secondary water source. Squad 3 and Engine 1 crews made entry into the structure. 32 arrived on scene and crew went to the roof to vent. Engine 2 arrived on scene. The bulk of the fire was knocked down and contained to the kitchen area. Crews started checking for extension. Tower 4 arrived on scene. Sparta R.I.C was cancelled. PPV was set up at the door to ventilated while overhauling. 32 fire crews secured the power to the building. The front apt was checked for co readings (9ppm) the front apt was ventilated. Sussex County Fire Marshall on Scene and their investigation. Overhaul was Complete. Building official was notified. 32 Fire was released from the scene as well as Fireman and Stillwater from covering the stations. Crew members escorted the tenants to help get belongings. All Newton Units cleared. Sussex County Fire Marshals office investigated
