ALL UNITS RESPONDED TO NEW BRUNSWICK AVE FOR A REPORT OF AN OUTSIDE FIRE AGAINST THE BUILDING. UPON ARRIVAL BATTALION 3 ASSUMED COMMAND. WE HAD A LARGE OUTSIDE RUBBISH FIRE WITH POSSIBLE EXTENSION INTO THE STRUCTURE, A SINGLE STORY NON-COMBUSTABLE UNOCCUPIED WAREHOUSE. ENG 3 STRETCHED A 2 1/2 INCH LINE FOR EXTINGUISHMENT. ENG 4 SUPPLIED ENG 3 WITH 5" LDH AND STRETCHED AN ADDITIONAL 1 3/4 LINE TO ASSIST . TRUCK 10 FORCED DOORS TO THE STRUCTURE AND INVESTIGATED THE INTERIOR FOR EXTENSION. A 15 MIN RECALL OF RFD PERSONAL AND A COVER ASSIGNMENT WAS ORDERED. CREWS EXTINGUISHED THE FIRE USING 2 LINES. NO EXTENSION TO THE INTERIOR OF THE BUILDING, ALTHOUGH WE HAD DAMAGE TO THE EXTERIOR SHEATHING OF THE STRUCTURE. TRUCK 10 WAS SENT TO THE ROOF TO CHECK FOR ANY EXTENSION WITH NONE FOUND. THE FIRE OFFICIAL WAS CALLED TO THE SCENE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF CODES. ENG 1 TO THE SCENE FOR MANPOWER. AFTER OVERHAUL, BUILDING WAS RELEASED BACK TO THE BUILDING OWNER. ALL UNITS CLEAR COMMAND TERMINATED.
