Narrative: Responded on a signal nine to 201 Mountain Avenue on a report of smoke coming from an oven. On arrival command was established with nothing showing. The fire department and gained entry and found a light smoke condition coming from around the oven. The fire department pulled the oven out and found smoke coming from around the cabinets. The Springfield Fire Department was requested to check the basement. The cause of the smoke condition was found coming from a trash can under the kitchen sink. Smoldering towels were found in the trash can, and were removed to the exterior and extinguished. Ventilation was used to remove the smoke condition. A signal 102 was conducted by an on duty firefighter. The owner was informed of the fire departments findings, and to contact the fire department if needed.
