11. Narrative

On Wednesday, November 10th 2021 at approximately 2006 hours, Ptl. Hyndman and I were dispatched to 251 Hillside Ln. for the report of a dwelling fire with possible people trapped inside. Upon arrival, I observed a severe smoke condition as well as large visible flames coming from the bravo side of the residence. I was then met by the caller, Joshua Smith, that stated his brother, Christopher Smith and Andrea Albarracin may still be inside the residence. Joshua stated that both Chris and Andrea's vehicles were on location. The smoke and fire conditions were to great to go inside at this time. A short time later, Joshua called Christopher and it was reported that Christopher and Andrea were not inside, and went to go get ice cream.

A short time later Christopher and Andrea arrived on location. Multiple Fire Departments arrived on location for assistance.

At approximately 2339 hours, I spoke with Fire Marshall Joe Jackson who advised that the fire was not criminal in nature. The suspected source of the fire is believed to be a candle that was found on a bed in the downstairs bedroom belonging to Christopher and Andrea.

Nothing further to report at this time.
