On Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at approximately 0945 hours, Hedwig Ching came into Police Headquarters to file a report.

Ms. Ching reported that she used to work as a volunteer at Poconos Family Ministries. She had resigned a while back but the volunteer that took her position, Laura Herbers, called her recently with a concern. Ms. Herbers told Ms. Ching that there was an indecent exposing of a 20 year old male, Daniel Mizutani, to an unknown 15 year old male. This happened last year between April and August but it was only recently that a mother told Ms. Herbers about it. Ms. Ching was not given a name for the 15 year old or the mother but she believes they are not from the same family. Ms. Herbers told Ms. Ching that she reported this to the head of the organization, Michael Stewart but she is concerned that he seemed to be more concerned about protecting Daniel than the kids.

Daniel is the director of programs which has him watching over young adults. He has been known to say inappropriate things including things about gays. This was also reported to Mr. Stewart but nothing has been done about it. This recent knowledge was also reported to Sunkwon Bush, who is in charge of operations, which directors fall under, but it seems that nothing has been done as of yet.

Ms. Ching was given the number to New Jersey State Central Registry for child abuse and told to report this incident. This officer also called the hotline but was transferred to the Pennsylvania number (800-932-0313) and spoke with Megan (ID #350). Ms. Ching was given a case number and left Police Headquarters.

Ms. Ching also reported she spoke to the New Jersey State Central Registry. They asked her to report this to the Pennsylvania hotline also. She spoke with Carol (ID# 392). Carol told Ms. Ching that she would report the incident to Carbon County, where the Pennsylvania park is located. Ms. Ching also reported that she was advised to have this officer contact Carbon County to verify the report.

This officer called Carbon County Dispatch and was put in touch with Officer Yost from Kidder Township Police Department (570-722-0192) to inform them of the situation.

Coward had returned to school after making a terroristic threats on the grounds. See report #19MT14028 by Cpl. Chenoweth for initial information. When Mr. Coward returned to the school on 5/7/19, it was a day of taking PARCC tests for the students. Mr. Coward had taken a test on the computer on that day and answered an essay question with the statement, "Thorne Middle School is a bitch and I wanna shout up the school." A writing sample of Mr. Coward's was also provided with the statement to further provide evidence that Mr. Coward's statement was meant to say that he wants to shoot up the school. The response was flagged by the state when grading the PARCC tests and on this date, the response was made aware to Principal Olausen. Lt. Volkland and Det. Lt. Bailey were made aware of the statements made by Mr. Coward as well as his prior arrest for making similar statements and Det. Simon responded to Thorne Middle School to assist this officer with the progression of the incident. It was determined that Mr. Coward would be charged with Terroristic Threats at this time. Mr. Coward had already been dismissed from school to the custody of his grandmother, Hattie Hunter, and was not permitted to return to school grounds until he was fully cleared by CPC.

This officer and Det. Simon then responded to 240 First Ave to attempt to locate Mr. Coward. Upon arrival to the residence, we were let inside and met with Mr. Coward and Ms. Hunter. Ms. Hunter was aware of the allegations made by the school and was informed that Mr. Coward would be placed under arrest for Terroristic Threats. This officer placed Mr. Coward under arrest, handcuffed him, and placed him in the rear of Patrol Car #53. Mr. Coward was transported to police headquarters without incident. While at police headquarters, Det. Simon completed juvenile complaints and this officer fingerprinted and completed mug shots of Mr. Coward charging him with Terroristic Threats, 2C: 12-3a. Upon completion of processing, Mr. Coward was retrieved at police headquarters by Ms. Hunter. This officer contacted the ROIC in reference to the threats and provided them with the information which they required. No further actions were necessary at this time.

Narrative:

On 5-28-19 at approximately 2340 HRS while performing a security check of McMahon Park, I observed NJ registration V75KZV parked in the lot. The park closes at 8PM. Through my experience, McMahon park is often used for illegal activity after hours. I approached the vehicle and introduced myself to the driver, later identified as Daylon Wilkerson (19 YOA). I asked Wilkerson what they were doing and he stated that he was just about to smoke a black and mild. He also stated that his friend and passenger, Allajah Morin (19 YOA) lives around the corner. At this time, PTL. N. Zubkow #369 and PTL. D. Ringkamp #347 arrived as backup.

I asked Wilkerson why he came to the park to smoke the black and mild and not at his friends house. Wilkerson stated that he didn't feel right smoking it near his friends house. Wilkerson then stated that it was just a black and mild and that it wasn't weed or anything. I asked Wilkerson for his license and he asked Fernandez to look in the back for it. I observed Fernandez open a fanny pack to look and then immediately close it without looking inside of it. Wilkerson then immediately stated that he must have lost his wallet and does not have his ID. I then asked the front and back seat passengers if they had ID and they both provided me with it.

The back seat passenger was identified as Jason Fernandez (19 YOA). The front seat passenger, Morin, was very fidgety while I was speaking with Wilkerson. He flipped his phone in his lap and looked at it several times. I then asked county to run the subjects for warrants which was negative. County advised me at this time that Morin has had CDS history. I then asked Morin when he was last arrested and he stated in January for possession of marijuana.

At this time, I asked Wilkerson to step out of the vehicle so I could speak with him. I again asked Wilkerson what he was doing there and he again stated that he just wanted to smoke a black and mild. I advised Wilkerson that the park was closed and that people often park here after hours to use CDS. While speaking with Wilkerson, he would not make eye contact with me and continued to move around. Wilkerson also made a face time phone call while I was speaking to him

and he remained on the call the entire duration of the investigation.

I asked Wilkerson if there was anything illegal in the vehicle and he said no. I then asked him if anyone else in the vehicle had anything illegal on them and he said no. I asked Wilkerson if he would be willing to sign a consent to search form for his vehicle. At this time, Wilkerson got very hostile and stated no, we did not need to search his vehicle because there was nothing in it. I then asked Wilkerson why he got so upset when I asked for consent and he stated it was because there is nothing in the car and we will be wasting our time.

I advised Wilkerson of the process to have a K9 perform a sniff of the vehicle and advised him that I was going to call for one. I contacted SGT B. Dilworth #307 and he responded to the scene and called for a K9. Matawan K9 officer Mason and his K9 partner responded to the scene. Officer Mason and his K9 partner performed a sniff of the vehicle. After doing so, Officer Mason advised me that his partner did not indicate on any narcotics in the vehicle. He also advised me that his K9 is not trained for the scent of marijuana.

At this time, I issued Wilkerson 2 summons's for 39:3-29 and 39:4-135. The vehicle was sent on its' way with a different driver. No further action taken.
