The South Brunswick Board of Fire Commissioners for the South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on December 28, 2023. This response is being provided to you on January 4, 2024.

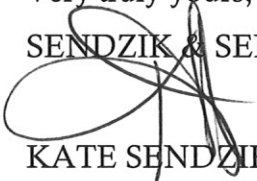
Your OPRA request sought access to the following document: "All business dealings the Kingston Volunteer Fire Company had with family members of David Luck from 1995 to present. Include property, investments and any services rendered. Please include the year, relationship and amounts paid or owed."

The South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 does not maintain or possess documents responsive to your request.

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
