I am writing on behalf of my client, the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office (the "MCSO"), in response to the records request that you submitted to the County under the Open Public Records Act (the "OPRA"), which was submitted by you on Sunday, February 12, 2023, and which was received by the MCSO on February 13, 2023. This records request was forwarded to our office, as special County Counsel for OPRA matters, in order to assist the County with the provision of a response. This response is being provided within the period of time required by law.

Your request was provided as follows (in bold):

Any and all documents, correspondence (including but not limited to e-mail, supporting documentation, physical documentation/marketing materials, internal messages & other forms of correspondence) pertaining to Flock and/or Flock Safety.

Attached to this email please find all documentation the MCSO has in relation to Flock and/or Flock Safety. The documents consist predominantly of email correspondence, with marketing materials as well as direct communication regarding potential purchases of service. We have also attached documentation relating to a purchase from Flock that did not ultimately take place. The MCSO has no contract with Flock. Thus, the materials MCSO has in relation to Flock are predominantly limited to email correspondence.

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been improperly denied, you have a right to challenge the decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing a Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer

other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
