At the above date and time patrols responded to 128 main street Apt [REDACTED] for a caller reporting that someone has been taking her Vacuum. Upon arrival patrols made contact with the caller, Abby Norris, who indicated that she has a eighty dollar purple vacuum clear which she keeps outside her apartment door for the safety of her child. Ms. Norris indicated that the vacuum has been sitting outside her apartment door in the communal area for months for the safety of her child, however indicated that she believes the neighbors in Apt [REDACTED] stole it. At this time patrols made contact with Ernest Sprague, resident of Apt [REDACTED]. Mr. Sprague indicated that he was the one who took the vacuum as he thought it was a communal vacuum in the foyer. Mr. Sprague returned the vacuum without incident and indicated that he was not going to be utilizing the vacuum any longer. Patrols cleared with no further action taken.
