Narrative

On 10/02/2024 at approximately 2213 hrs I responded to a report of a motor vehicle crash with overturn and entrapment in the area of 202 Derby Drive. At this time, I was assigned to Field Training Officer duties with my Officer in Training, P.O. DeFalco #302. P.O. DeFalco was driving and utilizing the radio for communications. Upon our arrival I observed the vehicle, a white Chevrolet Traverse bearing NJ registration Z65NAA, laying on its driver side along the northbound curb line. I also observed two signs that were down, a fire hydrant that was severed off of its base, and a damaged utility pole in the path of the vehicle. The driver had already been extricated by first responding officers and was standing in the front yard of a nearby residence without injury. I met with the driver, who identified herself as Anna Garrison, and obtained her account of the moments leading up to the crash. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] when a squirrel ran out in front of the vehicle. She said, "and I slammed on my brakes and ended up on the side." I confirmed that Garrison was uninjured and did not wish for medical attention.

As Garrison spoke, I could smell the overwhelming odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her mouth. Her speech was slow and extremely slurred. Due to these indicators, I asked her to step aside to the parking lot of nearby Laura Donovan School to perform Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST). There she was positioned on a flat, dry, well-lit surface made of blacktop that was clear of debris. The temperature was approximately 64°F and clear with no wind. Garrison was faced away from all emergency lights and spot lights prior to testing. At this time Garrison admitted to having "four or five" beers.

The first test I conducted on Garrison was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. For this test, I utilized a black pen as my stimulus. At the conclusion of my instructions she stated that she understood. I observed equal pupil size and equal tracking in both eyes. I also observed lack of smooth pursuit and distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. Last, I observed onset of nystagmus prior to 45° and Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN) in both eyes. Garrison told me that she usually wears glasses but did not have any other eye problems nor neurological issues that would cause eye problems.

The next test I attempted to conduct was the Walk and Turn test. Garrison was initially hesitant but eventually agreed to take the test. A solid white parking stall divider was utilized as a visual straight line. Since Garrison was wearing sandals, I gave her the option to remove them for better balance which she did choose to do. When I attempted to place Garrison in the starting position, she immediately lost her balance and stated, "I can't even do this sober." She then refused to continue any testing without her husband present.

Based on the totality of the foregoing, Garrison was placed under arrest for N.J.S.A 39:4-50 Driving While Intoxicated. She was handcuffed behind her back, searched, and placed in the rear prisoner compartment of marked patrol unit #611. At this point, members of Freehold First Aid approached the patrol vehicle and gave Garrison another opportunity to seek medical attention. She again declined and insisted that she was not injured. Garrison was transported to FTPD headquarters where she was read her rights under Miranda and agreed to answer questions. She was also read the New Jersey Attorney General Standard Statement and agreed to provide samples of her breath for testing. Garrison was extremely polite and cooperative throughout processing and completing the FTPD Impaired Driver Detail Report.

I processed Garrison on the Alcotest 9510 where she provided two valid breath samples which registered at .244% Blood Alcohol Content (BAC). Prior to doing so, Garrison's mouth was checked for foreign objects and a twenty-minute observation period was conducted where she did not not belch, vomit, or regurgitate. All portable electronic devices were removed from the immediate area of the Alcotest machine prior to its operation.

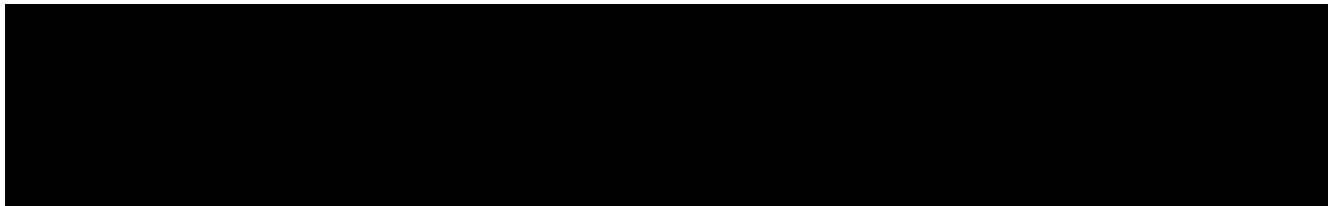
