The Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority (TRMUA) received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on March 12, 2026. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 23, 2026. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 7th business day after the TRMUA's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

I would like the fuel usage logs for new TR Twp. Vehicle ID 0045365 from September 2025 (or when the new key fob was activated) to February 13, 2026. The report should include total gallons, date, time, user if available and vehicle information. Thank you.

Please see attached fuel log information.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
