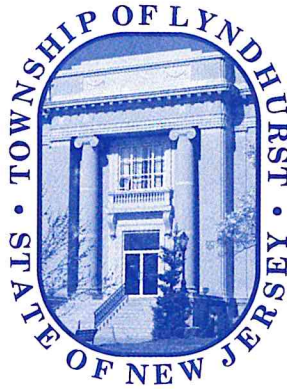

I am writing you in response to your request under the Open Public Records Act (N.J.S.A. §47:1A-1 *et seq.*, "OPRA") dated April 6, 2020.

You requested:

The Township does not maintain any document responsive to this request, so therefore none is being provided. OPRA defines a "government record" as any paper or other tangible material that has been made, maintained or kept on file in the course of the public entity's official business. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.
- Copy of all private messages from the Lyndhurst police department that is most current as of April 6, 2020 through April 10, 2020 with subject "giveaway and or gift cards"

- Copy of the profanity filter page on the Lyndhurst police departments Facebook page that is most current as of April 6, 2020
Please see attached response.
- Copy of 5e banned profile page from the Lyndhurst police department that is most current as of April 6, 2020
The Township does not maintain any document responsive to this request, so therefore none is being provided. OPRA defines a "government record" as any paper or other tangible material that has been made, maintained or kept on file in the course of the public entity's official business. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.

If your request for access to a governmental record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Lyndhurst to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866.850.0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

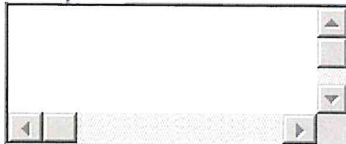

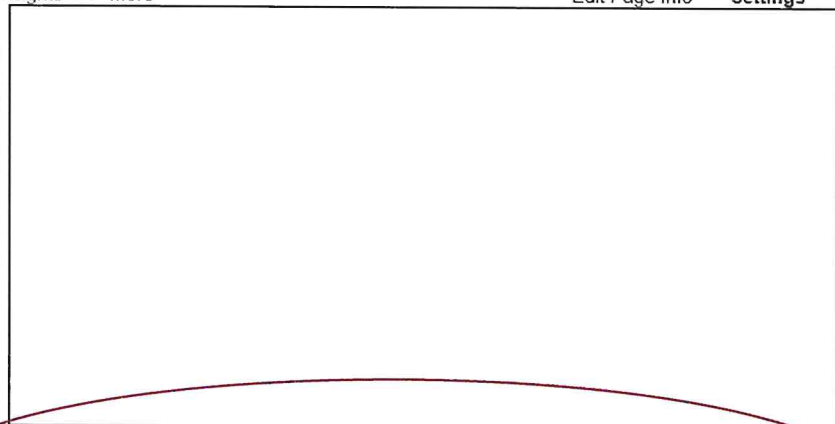
