The Carteret Police Department is in receipt of your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (NJSA 47:1A-1) dated, February 20, 2021. The Carteret Police Department Official Records Custodian, Captain Jeffrey VanWoeart received your OPRA request on February 22, 2021. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 3, 2021. This response is being provided on the seventh (7th) business since your request was submitted.

The following specific records have been requested:

I would like a copy of all police reports for 102 Hagaman St in Carteret NJ from January 1, 2007 through February 19, 2021

I would like a copy of all police reports Generated by Mohammed Radwan/MARIE CALOGERO in them from January 1, 2011 through February 19, 2021

I would like a copy of all police body camera footage from 102 Hagaman St from January 1, 2019 through February 19, 2020

Records responsive to this request:

*I would like a copy of all police reports for 102 Hagaman St in Carteret NJ from January 1, 2007 through February 19, 2021

Investigation reports have been located . Investigation reports are Criminal Investigatory Records. Criminal Investigatory Records are exempt from release under OPRA. Pursuant to NJSA 47:1A-1.1, criminal investigator records are "records which are not required by law to be made,

maintained or kept on file that are held by a law enforcement agency which pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding.

N.J.S.A 47:1A-1 Victims' records - Any written OPRA request by a crime victim for a record to which the victim is entitled to access, including, but not limited to , any law enforcement agency report, domestic violence report and temporary or permanent restraining order.

Medical Reports have been located. **N.J.S.A 47:1A-1**

Investigation reports have been located . Investigation reports are Criminal Investigatory Records. Criminal Investigatory Records are exempt from release under OPRA. Pursuant to **NJSA 47:1A-1.1**, criminal investigator records are “records which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file that are held by a law enforcement agency which pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding.” Therefore your request is denied.

N.J.S.A 47:1A-1 Victims' records - Any written OPRA request by a crime victim for a record to which the victim is entitled to access, including, but not limited to , any law enforcement agency report, domestic violence report and temporary or permanent restraining order.

Medical Reports have been located.

Kean in 1983, states that fingerprint cards, plates and photographs and other similar criminal investigation records which are required to be made, maintained or kept by any State or local governmental agency shall not be deemed to be public records subject to inspection and examination and available for copying pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 73.

N.J.S.A 47:1A-1 privacy Interest- a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizens personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizens reasonable expectation of privacy

*I would like a copy of all police body camera footage from 102 Hagaman St from January 1, 2019 through February 19, 2020.

34 incidents have been located at 102 Hagaman St. from January 1, 2019 through February 19, 2020. Due to the large amount of incidents multiple BWC recordings will have be researched reviewed and possibly redacted according to law. This request is broad and has the potential to substantially disrupt agency operations. Per N.J.S.A 47:1a-5g I would like to reach a reasonable solution that will accommodate you and the department. Please provide the date, time and the officer/s names involving the incident you are requesting BWC's for. Please email me your response.

If you are requesting under common law, you must articulate your legal interest in the subject matter contained in the material, then the material may be disclosed if under a balancing test your right of access outweighs the states interest in preventing disclosure. Please articulate your legal interest.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days by law, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Carteret Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint form.
