RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 9**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wallington has a need to engage the services of a Municipal Labor Attorney for the year 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wallington is required to comply with the New Jersey Pay-to-Play Law (P.L. 2004 c. 19, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et. seq.) (“Act”); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wallington followed the guidelines as set forth in the New Jersey Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law issued by the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wallington advertised for submission or “Requests for Qualifications” (“RFQ”) at least 10 days in advance of the opening of such qualifications in accordance with the aforesaid law; and

WHEREAS, the proposals and qualifications have been reviewed by the Mayor and Council who considered experience and reputation in the field; the contractor’s knowledge of the Borough of Wallington; the subject matter addressed under the contract; the availability to accommodate any meetings; and other factors deemed to be in the best interest of the Borough of Wallington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wallington, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that, law firm of Genova Burns, 494 Broad Street, Newark, NJ is hereby appointed “Municipal Labor Attorney” for the Borough of Wallington effective from the date of this Resolution through December 31, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the award of the contract for Municipal Labor Attorney for the year 2018 is made pursuant to a “Fair and Open” process; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Borough Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Contract in accordance with this Resolution and as set forth in the Qualification Statement submitted to the Borough of Wallington.
