State vs. Gerard A Grimes, Jr.  
Warrant # 1326-W-2019-000224

On Saturday, October 5, 2019, at approximately 9:30 PM, patrol officers from the Manalapan Police Department were dispatched to 25 Fawn Run in Manalapan, New Jersey for a reported "fight call" between the 9-1-1 caller's husband and an unknown individual. Additional information received by officers advised of multiple individuals with guns at the rear of the aforementioned residence. Responding Manalapan Police Department personnel were subsequently advised of shots fired with a possible gunshot victim.

Patrol officers arrived at 25 Fawn Run and discovered a gunshot victim later identified as Narciso Rodriguez-Corona, DOB: 04/06/1976 (hereinafter, "the victim") lying on the sidewalk in front of 25 Fawn Run. Patrol officers discovered that the victim suffered from what appeared to be an apparent gunshot wound to the chest / abdominal area of his body.

Manalapan patrol officers provided the victim with life-saving measures at the scene. The victim was then transported to Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital located in New Brunswick, New Jersey where he was later pronounced deceased.

Information provided by witnesses at the scene revealed that the victim's son resided at 25 Fawn Run. On the night of the incident, several of the victim's family members, including the victim and the victim's brother were present at the residence. At approximately 9:20 PM, multiple unknown individuals arrived at 25 Fawn Run and attempted to gain access to the residence through a side door. The residents of the home, including the victim, exited the residence in an attempt to confront the individuals. The victim then engaged in a brief physical confrontation with one of the subjects who was later identified as Gerard A. Grimes (DOB: 01/02/1996) (hereinafter, "Grimes"). Two (2) other individuals were also identified as being outside of 25 Fawn Run at the time. Following the physical altercation, Grimes ran south on Fawn Run towards Deer Way.

The residents of the home, including the victim, briefly chased Grimes on foot before getting into a Jeep Cherokee owned by the victim's family. The residents of the home, including the victim then pursued Grimes north on Pension Road and then east on Union Hill Road. They ultimately caught up to Grimes in the area of Union Hill Road and Kathleen Court. At that time, all three (3) individuals exited the Jeep Cherokee and approached Grimes. Grimes then fired several rounds at them, one of which struck the victim in the chest / abdominal area of his body. The victim was subsequently placed back into the Jeep Cherokee and driven to 25 Fawn Run. Grimes fled the area on foot towards a wooded area near the intersection of Union Hill Road and Kathleen Court. Police officers from multiple municipalities responded to the scene and began to search for Grimes, as well as all other individuals involved in the altercation at 25 Fawn Run.

At approximately 11:10 PM, an officer with the Manalapan Police Department observed a grey 2014 Nissan Altima occupied by three (3) individuals travelling on Kimberly Court. It was later determined that Grimes was the driver and registered owner of the vehicle. A motor vehicle stop was attempted by the Manalapan Police Officer; however, the Nissan



Altima turned around and failed to stop. The vehicle's path was ultimately blocked by multiple patrol units. At that time, Grimes stopped the vehicle and fled on foot. The two (2) other individuals remained inside the vehicle. They were subsequently detained and transported to the Manalapan Police Department in furtherance of the aforementioned investigation.

Grimes was ultimately apprehended by personnel with the Freehold Township Police Department and Manalapan Police Department in the area of 8 Kerwin Court, Manalapan. The Nissan Altima was secured and subsequently transported to the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office forensic garage pending an application for a search warrant.

Members of the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office also responded and began an investigation. During the course of said investigation, three (3) 9 mm shell casings were found near the intersection of Union Hill Road and Kimberly Court, Manalapan. Additionally, an Apple iPhone in a red color case with a smashed/broken screen was located on a grass partition on the side of Union Hill Road, between Kimberly Court and Pension Road.

A voluntary statement was obtained from a witness (witness # 1) who reported that Grimes and several other individuals arrived at 25 Fawn Run to engage in a physical altercation with the victim's son. When they arrived and entered the residence, a physical altercation ensued between Grimes and the victim. The residents of the home got involved in the altercation carrying weapons forcing Grimes and the other individuals to flee the area. The victim and several of his family members pursued Grimes and the other individuals as they fled the area. The witness advised that Grimes was walking on Union Hill Road when he was nearly struck by a vehicle being driven by the victim's brother. The witness reported that as Grimes attempted to run away, he was pursued by the victim and his family members. The witness advised that Grimes fired several gunshots that caused the victim to drop to the ground. The witness reported that the victim was then placed back into the vehicle and left the area.

A voluntary statement was obtained from a witness (witness # 2) who reported that he and Grimes traveled to 25 Fawn Run to engage in a fight. When they arrived, they went to the side of 25 Fawn Run where a physical altercation ensued between Grimes, the victim and several of the victim's family members. The witness reported that Grimes was in possession of a handgun at the time of the incident. Following a brief altercation, several of the victim's family members exited the residence carrying weapons causing Grimes and the other subjects to flee the area. Several minutes later, the witness reported hearing several gunshots.

Gerard Grimes, Jr. was interviewed at the Manalapan Township Police Department. The interview was video recorded. Gerard waived Miranda and agreed to speak with law enforcement personnel regarding this investigation. Gerard advised that he and several other subjects traveled to 25 Fawn Run for the purpose of engaging in a physical altercation with the victim's son and the victim's son's girlfriend. After approaching the residence and engaging in a brief altercation with the victim, Grimes advised that several family members exited the residence and pursued him as he fled the area on foot. Grimes reported that the

victim and his family members were in possession of weapons as they pursued him. Grimes reported that he was armed with a Smith and Wesson 9mm handgun at the time of the incident. Grimes explained that as he continued to flee the area, he was nearly struck by a vehicle occupied by the victim and his family members. Grimes advised although he attempted to flee from the victim and his family members, they continued to pursue him armed with a machete. In an effort to get the victim and his family members to cease their pursuit, Grimes reported that he fired several gunshots in the direction of the victim and his family members. Grimes advised that after firing the gunshots, the victim and his family members stopped pursuing him. Grimes explained that he ran into a wooded area in search of his vehicle which was parked nearby. Grimes advised that he retrieved his vehicle and met with two (2) other subjects whom he planned to leave the area with. Upon being confronted by law enforcement, Grimes advised that he turned his vehicle around and fled. He reported pulling over and fleeing from the officers on foot. Grimes advised that while fleeing from the officers, he dropped his handgun in a wooded area.

Gerard Grimes agreed to travel with members of the investigative team for the purpose of identifying the location where he dropped the handgun. Grimes was transported to the location on Kimberly Court where his vehicle was abandoned when he fled from the police on foot. A search of the area was conducted by officers and a 9mm Smith and Wesson Handgun was located behind a fence in the rear yard of 24 Kimberly Court, Manalapan, NJ.

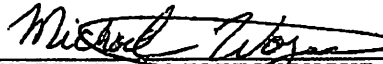
