The Borough of Glassboro Police Records Custodian received your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (OPRA), dated March 27, 2025, via email on March 28, 2025. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA is April 8, 2025. This response is being provided on the same business day after receipt of your request.

Arrest reports related to traffic stops including officer narrative from 01/01/2025 to 01/14/2025.

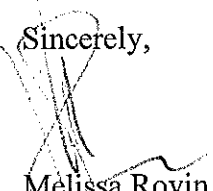
A search of our available records has identified no records responsive to your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Glassboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
