Dear S. Elaine:

Stockton University's Open Public Records Act (OPRA) Custodian received your OPRA Request on January 13, 2021. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is January 25, 2021. By letter dated January 25, 2021 the OPRA Custodian extended the response time until February 1, 2021 to further search for records requested and review records received, if any, for responsiveness.

Your OPRA Request sought access to the following:

**I would like to rephrase my request.**

**On October 27, 2020, the New Jersey State Council on the Arts awarded the following Stockton University entities 2021 Grant Awards:**

**Noyes Museum, \$26,633**

**Performing Arts Center, \$101,020**

**Stockton University (State of the Arts), \$250,000**

. . . .

**I am requesting the grant application and/or documentation that Stockton University submitted in order to receive the above referenced grants.**

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to search for and review records responsive to the request, if any. OPRA allows custodians extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

**Your request requires an extension of time of an additional five (5) business days, until February 8, 2021.**

If your request for access to a government record has been denied, you have a right to challenge the decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council

("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511; by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625; by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us); or, at its web site located at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about OPRA. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
