Tabernacle Township has received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request dated **08/19/2019**. The official Records Custodian received your request on **08/19/2019**. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is **08/28/2019**.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following information:

JOHN JOHNSON - Ownership records of Haines Lane. Is this a privately owned roadway.
Maintenance records of Haines Lane. Copy of any permit(s) for construction of gate on Haines Lane at Carranza Road

Your request is in review as of **08/19/2019** and will be responded to within 7 business days.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by Tabernacle Township to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
