On 4/8/2024 at approximately 0429 hours PO Gilleo 548 and I (PO Gigliotti 547) were patrolling the area of Joseph St. and S. Broad St. in marked unit 709 when I observed a silver bicycle lying in the grass area of the sidewalk besides a silver Dodge Ram truck bearing PA Reg. ZSZ6749 (Victim) which was parked on Joseph St. As we passed the vehicle, the headlights of our patrol car illuminated the inside of the truck and I observed an unknown male inside of the vehicle. I turned our patrol vehicle around in the intersection of Joseph St. and Genessee St. to stop behind the the truck and further investigate.

PO Gilleo and I exited our patrol vehicle and approached the passenger side of the truck to find the rear passenger side window to be smashed and a male, later identified as Eduardo Lozada Jr. (Arrestee), was inside. We gave Eduardo multiple commands to remain inside of the vehicle and not make any sudden movements. Eduardo refused to listen to our commands and jumped through the smashed window to exit the vehicle. Again, we gave Eduardo commands to not move however began to run down Joseph St. toward S. Broad St. A foot pursuit was called over the issued radios and multiple police units responded to the area. After a brief chase, PO Gilleo was able to apprehend Eduardo however, while attempting to place Eduardo into handcuffs he began to tense his arms and grab onto the handcuffs with his right hand. Eduardo was eventually handcuffed behind his back using the double locking method which were checked for fit. Eduardo was searched incident to arrest and was found to be in possession of a screw driver, a crack pipe and assorted change totaling \$4.24. Eduardo was placed into the rear of marked unit 709 which was checked prior to and after transport yielding negative results for contraband.

While on scene, a check of the vehicle revealed a large metal file which is believed to be used to smash in the rear window of the truck. An ET was requested to take pictures of the truck and collect the file inside of the vehicle and PO Elmer 519 responded to the scene (see his supplemental report for further details). Multiple police units checked the area to identify any other victim vehicles to no avail.

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Eduardo was transported to Hamilton Police Headquarters in marked unit 709 without incident. While en route to headquarters we requested for EMS to respond to headquarters for medical evaluation of Eduardo due to his demeanor, stating he was high on crack cocaine and not having slept in seven days. Ultimately Eduardo refused medical attention and was processed according to department policy. Eduardo was placed into holding cell #4 until transport to Mercer County Correctional Facility.

Complaint Warrant 1103 W 2024 000625 against Eduardo for 2C:36-2a, 2C:18-2a(1), 2C:17-3a(1), 2C:29-2a(1), 2C:29-1a, 2C:5-5a(1). The registered owner of the truck, Damion Heron (Victim), was contacted and made aware of the incident. Damion advised he had an unknown amount of change in the rear of the truck. Damion advised he was currently out of the country, but he would advise his wife of the incident. A Victim Notification Form was completed. The screwdriver, money, crack pipe were all entered into the BEAST Evidence Log and placed into temporary locker #3. The bicycle was transported back to headquarters in marked unit 712 by PO Baeza 561 and was entered into the BEAST Evidence Log to be placed into Building 102.

Eduardo was remanded to the Mercer County Workhouse to await arraignment. CIB was notified of the incident.

Use of Force was completed by PO Gilleo (see his supplemental report for further details).
