11-27-19, ONSTE. I MET WITH THE STORE MANAGER SCOTT JORDAN, [REDACTED]. WE DISCUSSED THE COMPLAINT. HE TOLD ME THAT HE HAD SPOKE WITH THE COMPLAINANT, WHO WAS IRATE. HE FURTHER STATED THAT ON THAT OCCASSION THE PERSON IN QUESTION, HAD ENTERED WITH A NON SERVICE ANIMAL. THE PERSON AND THE DOG WERE FOUND AND REMOVED BY MANAGEMENT. SCOTT TOLD ME THAT AS PER CORPORATE POLICY NON SERVICE ANIMALS, ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE ESTABLISHMENT. ALSO NO ANIMALS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SHOPPING CARTS. AS PER MANAGEMENT SIGNS ARE POSTED CONSPIUOUSLY AT THE ENTRANCES FOR PATRONS TO BE MADE AWARE OF THIS POLICY. WE VISITED THE ENTRANCE AND THESE SIGNS WERE IN PLACE. DURING THE TIME OF MY INVESTIGATION, I DID NOT OBSERVE ANY PATRONS ENTERING WITH ANY ANIMALS. AS PER MANAGEMENT WHEN A PATRON ENTERS WITH AN ANIMAL AND USES A CART. ONCE THE PERSON

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AND ANIMAL ARE REMOVED. THE CART IS THEN CLEANED AND SANITIZED.

THERE IS NO FURTHER CAUSE FOR ACTION AT THIS TIME BY THE OCDH.
