4/12/18 - Arrived on site at approximately 1545 hours. Met with Manager Ed Bond at this time in order to discuss the complaint. This establishment was inspected on 10/18/17 in which a Satisfactory rating was give. All of the refrigerators and freezers appeared to be in good working order while holding adequate temperatures. All Food remains adequately protected from contamination prior to being cooked and/or served. The lettuce used for caesar was not wilted or discolored in any noticeable way. Food managers at this location are ServSafe Certified. Proper cooking temperatures and hand washing procedures were reviewed while on site. No issues noted at this time.
