Complaint Investigation Narratives

Arrived on site at approximately 1400 hours. Met with the owner at this time in order to discuss the complaint submitted. All employees were witnessed to be wearing masks at this time. The issue concerning the handling of food and money was also discussed with the owner. Gloves are necessary when handling ready to eat foods and therefore those preparing sub sandwiches or salads are required to wear gloves or use utensils to avoid touching these food directly. However persons only handling money do not need gloves and are not to be handling food simultaneously. Handling pizza dough directly with bare hands is permitted as it will be subsequently put in the oven and cooked. No issues witnessed while on site.
