Description

The raw sewage drain was open and sprayed on the raw meat. The temperature can not be maintained in the meat fridge. One case freezes while the other one is too warm. The meat dolly is cleaned with bleach and the bleach is left on it. Old spoiled chicken is repackaged with different dates and different brand names and put back out for sale.

Onsite, I met with Andrew Larson, Asst.store manager (732-477-7906) and the Meat Dept. Mgr. Steve. They were not aware of the complaint. We reviewed the issues listed in the complaint and conducted a kitchen investigation.
As per Steve there had been a back up in the floor plumbing a month ago. This blockage was cleared by the corporate plumbing team, and proper protocol was followed. The area was cleared before the work was done to prevent splash onto food products.
Meat Dollies are cleaned with an approved bleach cleaner and are properly rinsed as per store policy.
As per management all meats arrive with a sell by date. Chicken arrives fresh and is processed and the sell by date is placed on the individual packages. As per management , expired items are discarded. Refrigeration unit temps. were satisfactory.

This complaint was not verified. There is no further cause for action at this time by the OCHD.
