6-29-16 14:00 hours Arrived at location. Spoke with an Owner. He was aware of the incident. He had not received any other complaints. Checked the facility for proper food handling, food holding temperatures, sanitizing procedures, etc.. Observed several refrigerators above 41 degrees F. Moved potentially hazardous food to refrigerators holding code temperatures. Obtained evidence that some food items were not always being cooked to the minimum required temperatures. Reviewed proper internal minimum temperature requirements for the potentially hazardous foods. Reviewed proper sanitizing procedures, and food handling. Informed Owner a return visit to verify compliance would be performed. Departed site 14:45 hours.

7-5-16 13:30 hours Returned to location due to fire. The facility suffered severe damage. All products embargoed. Facility to remain closed for an undetermined time.
