- Renovation of leaking roof (removed) and new facade. Interior complete gut and replacement of bathrooms and seating area and front counter area.

Observed:

- Construction dust being tracked into the front counter food prep and handling area from the construction area. Cleaned up at s time.
- Temporary lights and plastic sheeting, floor to ceiling and sealed are observed in place.

Spoke by telephone to owner's daughter Kristin Hulling 732-995-3337 and reviewed tat no written Food Plan was

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submitted to OCHD as required and needs to be provided for review and approval asap. Kristin indicated a plan will be furnished by Monday.

With proper separation of work spaces from construction areas and a temporary bathroom with hand sink furnished, food service at drive through may continue.

Complaint is closed with no cause for further action by this agency. Upon completion, and prior to re-opening, OCHD will perform an inspection.
