Complaint Investigation Narratives

Dwight Gerdes, REHS meets with Brick Convenience manager and speaks with owner (Mike Patel) by telephone about this complaint. Owner is aware of the complaint and indicates:
- Former employee made a mistake. Products made by employee are now pulled from sale. All foods are in code now.

Findings:

- Half & half milk is labeled to expire today. all other dairy products are in code and no expiration dates are blacked out with markers.
- One product was found to be out of code: Oaxaca Mole with use by date 1/30/18. Owner agrees to remove that item from sales shelves.

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Call placed to complainant while on site. Complainant is unavailable. Left a message requesting a return call.

With owner correcting "MisBranding" problems on site by addressing the matter with the employee responsible for using a marker to hide expiration dates, removing all affected dairy products from the shelves and also removing one additional non-dairy food product due to being past labeled "Use by" date. Complaint is closed. No cause for further action by this agency at this time.
