Arrived on site at approximately 9:45 hours. On site at this time was Brick Twp Fire Prevention Specialist David Bahrenburg along with Wendy's District Manager Jane Beutel. During the previous night a fire occurred in one of the fryers that traveled up through the overhead hood system. The fire suppressant system was activated, subsequently putting out the fire. No extensive damage occurred. Because the restaurant was closed during this time and no food prep was being conducted, there was no need for the voluntary destruction of any food on site. At this time, it was requested that clean up of dry chemical suppressant be conducted as well as to take any necessary measures requested by local fire prevention. A return visit is to be made in order to confirm the completion of these requests.
