Any claim presented against a municipality is governed by New Jersey Statute Title 59. In brief, it states that any person(s) making a claim against a Municipality can collect only their deductible if the Municipality is proven negligent. Your insurance is primary and you must report this claim to them first.

As per our attached letter, your claim is denied. However, if you wish to pursue this claim further, the following must be presented within 90 days of the incident. [If you have already provided, please disregard.]

1 - a copy of your homeowner/property insurance declaration page to verify your deductible

2 - a copy of your estimate and pictures of the damage

3 - the enclosed claim form must be completed in full

You can file suit after 6 months of the storm event. Again, the Tropical Storm Isaias claim is denied.

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Is it possible to put a weekly reservation system in for the courts? If someone has a reservation they have priority that day.

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Got it. I don't have a problem with trainers charging for a lesson - that's what trainers do. I agree that it can't become their personal training ground while others are waiting, but I'm also not sure there are deep lines of people waiting to get on the courts every day. Do we know that for certain with data or are we just reacting to residents who have observed it on their own?

If the facility is not largely used during 7 to noon for non training, then perhaps the policy on the fence is an overreach and should be reexamined. What would be terrible is to kick off someone who is training and then have a different resident show us that for 6 of the 7 days during the week no one steps foot on the court during those hours of use.

Maybe we need to take a step back and see just how often those courts are being used during that time period. What I'd hate to see is a blanket restriction and then no one using the courts between 7 and 12 on a consistent basis. There's nothing more frustrating than seeing a facility blocked for time by someone and then showing up and seeing it not being used at all.

If this is a huge problem, we should approach these residents who train and identify a different time when they can do these lessons. And if you want, ask the trainers to somehow register with the town. that way we can have a solution that accompanies a restriction.

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Another question, Are the ones getting instruction people from Glen Rock? If they are, I don't see how their ability to learn is less important than other residents' opportunity to play. I think that's an important layer in all of this. If a resident was getting instruction and learning how to play tennis, he/she should have access to the court for instruction the same as a resident wanting to go and play for fun. Not sure if the lessons are for residents.

It is a green acres facility so we probably cannot restrict people from using the facility.

My observation is only based on 4 weekends so I am not sure if its the case all the time. I was there on two Sunday's and two Saturday's and I noticed that 3 of the 4 courts were being used for private lessons. I was there from 9-11.30 AM. A few of the people teaching have 2-3 hours of consecutive clients. I was happy to see that there is a sign suggesting that there should be no private lessons from 7am to 12 pm, but it seems that no one adheres to these rules. Even when I mentioned it to them last weekend, they came out looked at it, and one instructor gave us the court 30 mins afterwards, the other shrugged his shoulders and kept on with his private client. Unfortunately, there is also a lot of garbage, which I have no problem trying to pick up when I am there. People leave empty water bottles, wrappings and even coffee cups. I am happy to help with this, if you could use my help in any way. I am hopeful a solution can be found so that the instructors giving the lessons will do so during the allotted times and this will allow the people playing recreationally to play in the mornings. Recreation Advisory Board Meeting

Tuesday January 21, 2020

8pm

Agenda: Introduce New Liaisons: The two new liaisons for RAB will be Mary Barchetto and Rob Dill. Both have been involved in recreation and have children participate in programs. They're looking forward to working with RAB. Mary hopes to help the RAB tighten up compliances and get the updated bylaws approved and enforced.

- 1) Faber Update:** The council approved the engineering detailed plan and are waiting for the design which is for half grass half artificial turf with a basic asphalt walking path and conduits but no lights. The draft should be done by the end of February. An approximate construction end date if things stay on track would be December 2020. Every step we take is another hurdle and another vote. The hurdles will be the vote on the bond ordinance or facing another referendum. About 2.8 million needs to be approved. The vote would have to be a majority vote (4-2). The liaisons said that they were thinking a possible vote could happen in March at the meeting on the 11th.
- 2) Organic Treatments on Fields:** This topic has come up again from vocal residents who are concerned about how the fields are being treated and they would like to see organic. Mark emailed Katie stating that the RAB doesn't think organic is as effective as chemical. It has increased costs and the fact that it would have to be outsourced should be considered. The Board still has the same reservations they've had each time this is discussed and questioned why we would entertain this discussion again if we've seen Upper Faber brown with organics and then bounce back with the chemicals while the rest of our treated fields are fine. Another question posed was will taxpayers want to see this if we spend money on a turf/grass field. Katie said with the recommendation from DPW and other organic companies she would propose looking into a 90-10 split so that the field is treated with organics but the 10% would be pre-emergent and allow the company to spot spray weeds which would help keep the field from being choked out by weeds like Upper Faber was. The RAB was in agreement that their main concern is making sure whatever we use provides us with safe fields for our athletes. Katie will be providing the council with quotes from Organic landscapers she found through Rutgers.
- 3) Field Allocations Update:** Hamilton will be offline for spring. The baseball teams that use these fields should look at planning more away game or will be moved to Coleman or the multiuse fields at Faber. Lacrosse has been working on their schedule to use the school and away games as much as possible which should help alleviate some problems. Katie put in an application to the county for the use of the Fairlawn Pitch behind Oceanos to give soccer a place to go. Mens softball will get memorial, Upper and Lower Faber until 2pm since they lost Hamilton and have 10 teams again. Anytime they don't need

can be given back to the other programs. Frank will not have the HS schedule and blackout dates until the middle of February so we're at a standstill until then.

- 4) Rec Budget Proposals:** Katie had a 1st meeting to go over the budget plans for 2020 but the Rec Budget meeting has not been scheduled yet. Most of the operational is staying the same with increase for summer staff since minimum wage is increasing again. Capital Requests include Phase 2 of the tennis courts (basketball court included), Memorial Field Tuneup, Memorial Infield Renovations, Main Street Field Tune Up, Sycamore Tune Up, Upper Faber Tune Up (All tune-up came from the Viersma Proposal Little League obtained for RAB), a Senior Activities Instructor, New Hair catchers for the Kiddie pool (Main Pump filter is a priority, other 2 can even wait for 2021), laptop for pool manager, Media Filter Replacement for Pool, Security Cameras (being quoted with GRPD), and the Pool Pavilion (roof replacement or complete renovation with upgrades. Mary Barchetto has also been working to obtain a \$120,000 grant for the Seniors.

5) Member Reports

Board of Education Update: Post meeting, we learned that Sinead Rundell will be our new liaison.

Recreational Athletic Organization Updates

Little League- In the middle of registration. 377 so far and there is another month before the \$50 late fee kicks in. The younger grades has increased numbers. The Senior Team (13,14,15) is looking to play in a Junior Little League so they can enter the Little League Tournament. This would mean they have to travel a little further.

Lacrosse- Registration opened and there's 4 weeks before late fees kick in. Lax day is May 9. Games will be starting at the end of March which is earlier (weather permitting).

GRSC- Registration opened for spring soccer session for Pre-K-2nd grade.

GRSS- 135 kids for indoor soccer right now making it the most successful season. Getting ready for spring, scouring for field space and having to rent the Superdome.

Jr Football- The season ending dinner was in January. Registration will begin in March

Wrestling- 45 kids which is good but flat from 2019. There's a fair number of kindergarteners and 5 girls. The HS team is doing well. Weekend competitions are starting.

Basketball- In the middle of the season. 742 kids, 84 paid late fees. The Middle school opened up the doors from the parking lot making a lot easier with getting to the gym and so far there haven't been any problems. Gym time is still an issue and they get hammered with scheduling. Rec bball will be losing 12 games at the end of the season because the Robotics club will need the gym. Playoffs will be the 1st 2 weeks in March.

Men's Basketball-No Report

Men's Softball-There is a kickoff meeting in the next 2 or 3 weeks. 10 teams returning.

Dog Park- The dog park opened January 1 with its dedication. Lots of people have been going. Their fundraising goal is \$20,000 to finish paying for construction and to eventually put in a solar pavilion, charging station, and running water. They are going to start classes. DPW needs to move equipment from back lot. They are working with GREC to about solar panels and the Arboretum to plant trees. Not confirmed yet, but they are looking to hold their next event on February 14th. A doggie bag dispenser and garbage receptacles are needed.

Spring sports update: Most likely no regular spring sports season, however lacrosse and baseball would not rule out some sort of less formal summer league. Little League national is not officially making the determination for their season until May 11th.

Hamilton Field: Sinead Rundell reports overall the field is looking good with construction slightly ahead of schedule. Organizations like Little League would like to know if they will be allowed to perform routine maintenance (puddles) on the field or if all maintenance will be performed exclusively by DPW. This will be discussed.

Chris was then introduced as the new Borough of Glen Rock Recreation Director and he could not be happier to be here.

Budget: as of last meeting the budget was \$0 for 2020. Eileen questioned if this was finalized which Lenora said will be discussed on Wednesday night. Mary mentioned security cameras will have to be put off until next year as the fee could be substantial. GRPD has no plans to add cameras to the parks as of this time. Mary also mentioned a proper three to five-year plan for non-Faber Fields would be done and cameras can be added to that, with GRPD involved. Jon then suggested extra lighting may be an alternative measure to prevent vandalism but would also fall into a 3-5-year plan.

Pool: Lenora was able to report the heating projects are currently in the works, the facilities (locker rooms and restrooms) are in the works, and the pumps are currently being discussed but the goal being completion before opening. Lenora then suggested the borough reject the bids for the concession stand with concerns over the opening date as well as maintaining of kitchen infrastructure. Pool badges have been put on hold and are not being sold now with follow up discussions to be had over an opening date. Rob mentioned the possibility of pro-rated fees if the opening is later in the summer.

Capital Request Reports: Rob would like to see a five-year plan along with Chris giving his input now that he is on board. If the DPW operating budget can handle some smaller requests (low spots) this can be investigated, but any large projects will have to be put into a long-term plan. Mary stated her appreciation for the Capital request reports.

Sports Report: Matt has been enjoying the home videos and wanted to ask what baseball and soccer are doing regarding fees as he would like to avoid a long refund process. Jon mentioned older players aging out will be given a full refund while the rest will be given a credit to roll into next season. A refund is also an option, but most are taking the credit. Jim felt more comfortable refunding everyone through Team Snap. Matt mentioned kicking some money back into the community and Aaron said they have not officially cancelled the Spring soccer season but expects announcement soon. Jon asked if BOE fields will remain closed in the summer if schools remained closed to which Sinead said that call will come from the Governor.

Mary announced the shuttle is operating on limited runs to Kilroys and Shop Rite with no more than 5 residents and the driver wearing a protective mask.

Meeting adjourned.

Spring sports update: Most likely no regular spring sports season, however lacrosse and baseball would not rule out some sort of less formal summer league. Little League national is not officially making the determination for their season until May 11th.

Hamilton Field: Sinead Rundell reports overall the field is looking good with construction slightly ahead of schedule. Organizations like Little League would like to know if they will be allowed to perform routine maintenance (puddles) on the field or if all maintenance will be performed exclusively by DPW. This will be discussed.

Chris was then introduced as the new Borough of Glen Rock Recreation Director and he could not be happier to be here.

Budget: as of last meeting the budget was \$0 for 2020. Eileen questioned if this was finalized which Lenora said will be discussed on Wednesday night. Mary mentioned security cameras will have to be put off until next year as the fee could be substantial. GRPD has no plans to add cameras to the parks as of this time. Mary also mentioned a proper three to five-year plan for non-Faber Fields would be done and cameras can be added to that, with GRPD involved. Jon then suggested extra lighting may be an alternative measure to prevent vandalism but would also fall into a 3-5-year plan.

Pool: Lenora was able to report the heating projects are currently in the works, the facilities (locker rooms and restrooms) are in the works, and the pumps are currently being discussed but the goal being completion before opening. Lenora then suggested the borough reject the bids for the concession stand with concerns over the opening date as well as maintaining of kitchen infrastructure. Pool badges have been put on hold and are not being sold now with follow up discussions to be had over an opening date. Rob mentioned the possibility of pro-rated fees if the opening is later in the summer.

Capital Request Reports: Rob would like to see a five-year plan along with Chris giving his input now that he is on board. If the DPW operating budget can handle some smaller requests (low spots) this can be investigated, but any large projects will have to be put into a long-term plan. Mary stated her appreciation for the Capital request reports.

Sports Report: Matt has been enjoying the home videos and wanted to ask what baseball and soccer are doing regarding fees as he would like to avoid a long refund process. Jon mentioned older players aging out will be given a full refund while the rest will be given a credit to roll into next season. A refund is

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also an option, but most are taking the credit. Jim felt more comfortable refunding everyone through Team Snap. Matt mentioned giving some money back into the community and Aaron said they have not officially cancelled the Spring soccer season but expects announcement soon. Jon asked if BOE fields will remain closed in the summer if schools remained closed to which Sinead said that call will come from the Governor.

Mary announced the shuttle is operating on limited runs to Kilroys and Shop Rite with no more than 5 residents and the driver wearing a protective mask.

Parking at Coleman:

Mary mentioned parking at Coleman is still an issue as there have been complaints regarding people parking illegally on Benson and Spottswood. It was suggested those parking illegally are from out of town and can be rude to the homeowners when confronted.

Ryan stated the difficulty controlling those from out of town, especially once the games start and especially while monitoring COVID-19 restrictions.

Wilde Memorial Tennis Courts

Chris discussed the updated rules and regulations for the tennis courts, which contained mostly standard rules along with two changes. The first being limiting private instruction time to after peak hours (7:00am-12:00pm) and the second reserving court time for Senior Pickleball which will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00am- 10:00pm. These changes were considered after many phone calls with residents and Mark of the Senior Activities Club.

By -Laws:

Mary sent out the final draft of the RAB by-laws and asked if there were any more requested changes. The suggested term limit clock will begin on January 1st 2021 and Mark reviewed the final document one more time.

Vote on the by-laws passes unanimously.

Sports Report:

Basketball: Ryan mentioned the league may look into a fall season if allowed in gymnasiums, and if not there is a possibility of having an outdoor league which will require the use of Coleman. Discussions will continue.

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Dog Park- Michelle stated the dog park will be planning a 9/11 dedication and they will be launching a gofundme page in support of adding a garden. There will be an Eagle scout project proposed to add a gazebo as well. Maintenance of the dog park was discussed with DPW during a meeting today (August 18th). An agreement was reached for dpw to maintain the dog park like all borough parks.

Glen Rock Shooting Stars- Jon noted practices will begin August 24th with games taking place from Labor Day until the end of November. Summer volunteer practices have been going well and portable lights will be added to Memorial and Lower HS fields.

Glen Rock Soccer Club- Aaron stated GRSC will begin the first weekend after Labor Day. Travel will start 9/26 and trainers will be assisting the program as they have experience working within COVID-19 guidelines. So far the club has over 400 registered. Question was asked regarding the bathrooms which will be open for the entire fall sports season.

Football- Pete informed everyone they will not be participating in the league this season and will instead opt for having an in house Rec league on Tuesday-Thursday nights. High school staff will be assisting as well. Cheerleaders will practice outside on Wednesdays and cheer for the Thursday night 7 v 7 games. Pete cited there was just too many concerns regarding the league this season to vote yes on joining.

BOE: Sinead stated the BOE has joined a joint field maintenance contract with Ridgewood covering all the BOE fields. Jon asked if there was any news on Middle School soccer but the BOE is still waiting on word from the Governor.

Director's Report:

Park Damages from storm: All parks suffered some damage, from fallen branches to large downed trees. Demarest Park and Wilde Memorial suffered the most damage with large downed trees and branches throughout. Two outdoor dining tables were crushed at Demarest and there was downed wires at Wilde Memorial. All parks are still being cleaned up by the DPW.

Pool Update: Continuing with pool repairs while it is closed in order for a smooth opening next season. Some projects include

- Fence repairs
- Hot water heater for restrooms and locker rooms
- Features and columns in need of a fresh coat of paint
- Large pool to be drained, resealed, and refilled
- Touchless sinks and toilets
- Security cameras will be discussed
- Kiddie Pool pumps
- Retaining wall by pump room

DPW Report:-

- Still cleaning up after storm
- Demarest Park cleaned up

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- Wilde Memorial mostly cleaned up
- Third treatment will be in the next two weeks, just a fertilizer application so no fields will have to be closed.

Senior Services- We remain committed to providing transportation for our seniors as the bus has been continuing to provide service twice a week for groceries, and has started again to transport seniors to their appointments upon request. The bus runs from 8:30am – 2:00pm and appointments can be made by calling the borough clerk's office. On Fridays the bus runs from Glen Courts to Kilroys at 7:30am and Tuesdays to Stop and Shop at 9:30am. The bus is also available to those who are handicapped. The annex will remain closed for now so there are no gatherings or events.
