NARRATIVE

COMPLAINT:

On 04/21/2025 at approximately 13:38 hours, Somerset County Dispatch advised patrol that the Loss Prevention Manager of Weis Market reported a shoplifting incident from an earlier date. Somerset County Dispatch did not have any further information to provide at that time.

INTERVIEW WITH THE LOSS PREVENTION MANAGER: MASON VANHORN

Mason stated that on 04/07/2025 at approximately 12:30 hours, a middle age white female with dark hair walked into the Weis Market with a shopping cart to shop. Mason advised that after shopping for approximately one hour, the female attempted to walk out of the store without paying for the items in her cart. Mason advised that he confronted the female and requested for her driver's license, to which she complied and handed over her license. Mason advised that the accused stated, she was going to grab bags from her vehicle and come back inside to pay. Mason stated that he, in his experience as a Loss Prevention Manager, many shoplifters have used the same excuse when they are caught in the act of shoplifting. Utilizing the accused driver's license, Mason positively identified the suspect as Jaime L. Hardgrove and took a photo of the items in her shopping cart as well as the driver's license she provided. Mason stated that he ordered Jaime to return the items and to leave the store. Mason then ran the items through the register to get an exact stolen value of \$273.16. Mason provided patrol with a photo of the receipt, the suspect's driver's license, a photo of the items in the suspect's shopping cart, and video surveillance footage of the incident on a disc. Mason had no further information to provide at that time.

ACTION TAKEN:

Patrol provided Mason with a copy of his signed Property Loss Form. Patrol then made contact with the accused via cell phone at her residence of [REDACTED] Robin Road [REDACTED] Hillsborough, NJ, 08844 utilizing her son's cell phone. Jaime stated that she would respond to HTPD to give her statement. On 04/21/2025 at 16:05 hours Jaime arrived at HTPD to give her statement. Patrol escorted Jaime to the booking room and advised her that she was under arrest for shoplifting at Weis Market on 04/07/2025. Jaime was handcuffed to the booking room bench where she was processed.

INTERVIEW WITH ACCUSED: JAIME L. HARDGROVE

Jaime signed off on a Miranda Form after being read her rights. Jaime then stated that on 04/07/2025 at approximately 13:00 hours, she drove her son to Weis Market to start his shift, and so she could go grocery shopping afterward. Jaime stated that after she was done shopping, she walked out of the store with the shopping cart to grab shopping bags from her vehicle. Jaime stated that she had intentions of going back inside to pay after

she grabbed the bags from her vehicle but was stopped before she made it to her vehicle. Jaime advised that she was stopped by a Weis employee and forced to return her items. Jaime had no further pertinent information to provide with regards to the incident.

EVIDENCE:

The listed below items were entered into evidence and Watchguard.

FURTHER ACTION TAKEN / DISPOSITION:

Jaime was photographed, fingerprinted, and charged with Shoplifting 2C:20-11B(1) a disorderly person's offense on [REDACTED] Jaime was given her items and a copy of her [REDACTED] before being released. If any further information becomes available, it will be documented in a supplemental report. No further police action taken.

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
