NARRATIVE

COMPLAINT:

On 04/17/2025 at approximately 12:18 hours, Somerset County Dispatch advised patrol of a Shoplifting from Kohl's reported by the Loss Prevention Manager. Somerset County Dispatch advised that the incident was not in progress and occurred approximately one week prior to the call for service. Somerset County Dispatch did not provide any further information at that time.

INTERVIEW WITH THE LOSS PREVENTION MANAGER: ANDERSON FILS

Anderson stated that on 04/08/2025 at approximately 14:30 hours, a shoplifting incident occurred at the Hillsborough Kohl's in which a female stole a Shark vacuum worth \$229.00. Anderson stated that he did not personally observe the incident but reviewed the inside surveillance footage which captured the incident. Anderson described that a male staged a shopping cart with a Shark vacuum and left the cart near the front entrance of the store. Anderson advised that the male then left the store as a female walked inside and took the cart. The female took the cart outside to her vehicle where she unloaded the vacuum and left the Kohl's parking lot without paying.

Anderson advised patrol that he was the Loss Prevention Manger for multiple Kohl's locations in the area and stated that he recognized the female suspect from prior shoplifting attempts in Plainfield, East Brunswick, and Watchung. Anderson stated that she was possibly successful in East Brunswick, and Hillsborough Township but he was unable to identify the female suspect. Anderson provided patrol with a copy of the video footage on a disc as well as the receipt of the stolen item's exact value of \$229.00.

OBSERVATIONS:

Anderson provided surveillance video footage in which it could be seen that at 14:19 hours, a black sedan entered the Kohl's parking lot from Falcon Road. At 14:20 hours, an older white male wearing a dark jacket and dark pants exited the vehicle and entered the Kohl's front entrance and grabbed a shopping cart. The male then walked to the rear of the

store and placed a Shark vacuum in his shopping cart at 14:24 hours. At 14:25 hours, the male walked the filled shopping cart to the front of the store and left the cart near the front entrance before he left the store. One minute later at 14:26 hours, an older white female with blonde hair, a red sweatshirt, and dark pants walked into the store and grabbed the shopping cart that male had just brought to the front. The female suspect then took the cart out of the store through the front entrance without paying at 14:27 hours. The female walked towards her black sedan in the Kohl's parking lot and placed the vacuum into the vehicle, and both suspects left the scene. The black sedan traveled west out of the parking lot and made a right turn towards Opie Road. The vehicle could no longer be seen after that point.

ACTION TAKEN:
I provided Anderson Fils a copy of his signed Property Loss Form, and a business card. I then contacted the East Brunswick Police department to find out if they were able to positively identify the female suspect from their shoplifting incident in which they did not respond. I then submitted a facial recognition request to the State Police utilizing still shot photos taken from the video surveillance footage in an attempt to identify the two suspects. A Lens Flyer was then sent out to every police department in the state of NJ to identify the suspects utilizing the still shots provided.

Cpl. Anzalone was able to positively identify the suspects, as David C. Briganti, and Sandra A. Briganti based on previous encounters. The NJ Facial Recognition scan was returned by the State Police also confirming the suspects as David C. Briganti and Sandra A. Briganti from [REDACTED] Eves Drive [REDACTED], Hillsborough, NJ 08844. I attempted to contact both suspects to schedule an interview which yielded negative results. I then advised AP Hamilton of the incident, and she requested that all necessary information regarding the case paper screened.

NARRATIVE

COMPLAINT:

On 05/06/2025 the Somerset County Prosecutor's Office advised that they declined indictable fourth degree Shoplifting charges for both David and Sandra Briganti. The Somerset County Prosecutor's Office advised that a complaint could be signed in Municipal Court for both defendants.

ACTION TAKEN AND DISPOSITION:

Patrol responded to [REDACTED] Eves Drive unit number [REDACTED] in attempt to make contact with Sandra and David Briganti. Upon arrival, David C. Briganti opened the door to speak to patrol at which point he was place under arrest for Shoplifting a Shark vacuum on 04/08/2025 at the Hillsborough Kohls. David was then searched incident to arrest which yielded negative results and transported to HTPD to be processed. David was fingerprinted and charged with Shoplifting N.J.S. 2C:20-11b(1) on [REDACTED] David was provided a copy of his [REDACTED] and released to his residence at 11:55 hours.
