Based on the information I obtained yesterday from [REDACTED], I was able to interview an adult male subject today about supplying vaping products to our students. I subsequently arrested and charged the subject with NJ State Statute 2C:33-13.1A, Supplying Electronic Cigarettes to Persons Under Nineteen. The subject admitted to supplying two of our students with vaping supplies, but it is my belief that it was much more far reaching than that. The student's parents were already made aware that their child was involved in this activity. Hopefully this makes it more difficult for our students to obtain these supplies.

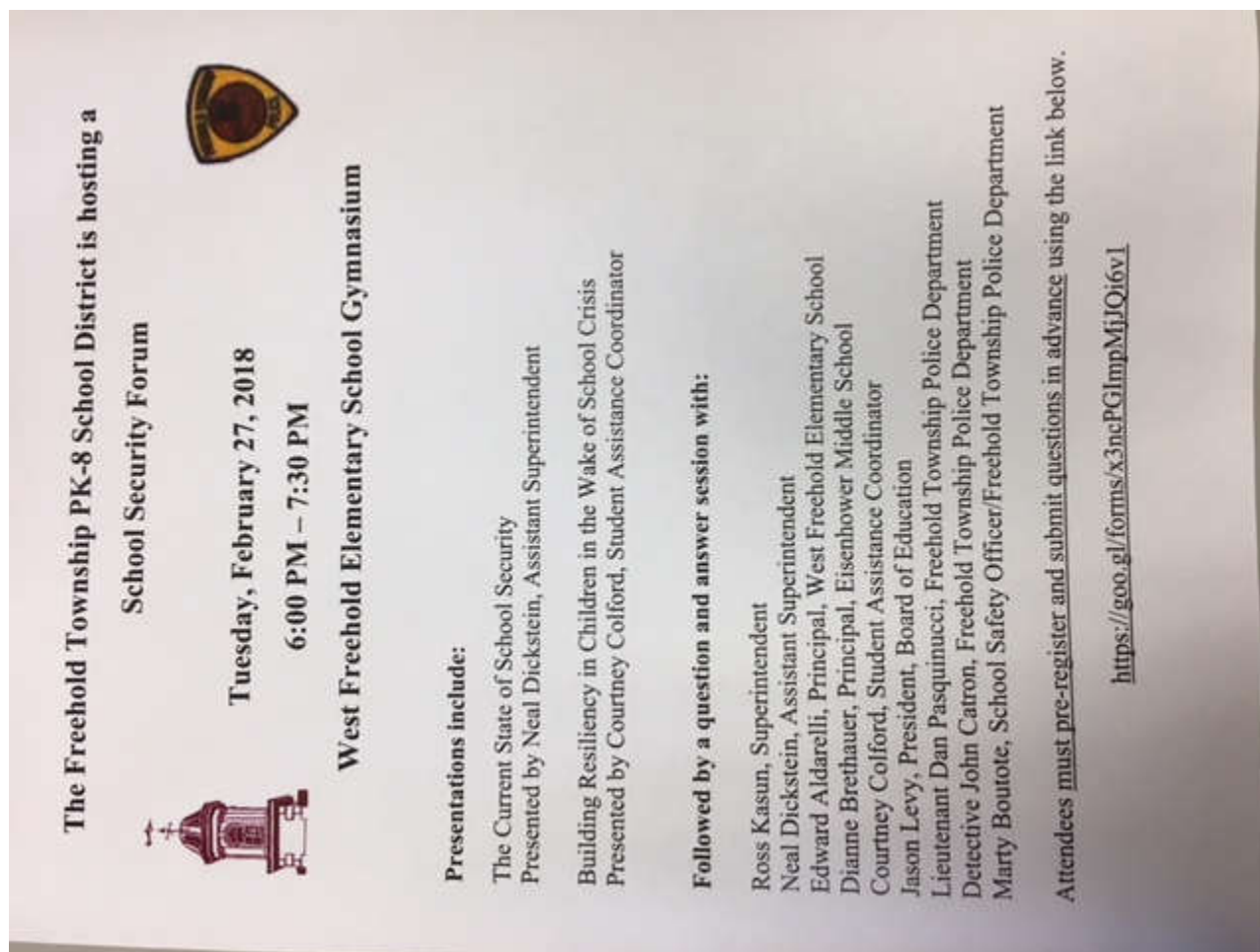
