The distance from where the accident took place to the school is approximately 3000 feet (according to township maps). In order for DWI in a school zone to be charged, the operation of the subjects vehicle needs to be within 1000 feet of school property. The subject's vehicle never reached the required distance for that additional charge. However, the officer did note in his report that the school was in close proximity to the accident. Additionally, if the accident did not occur, the subject would have entered a school zone at a time where students were likely to be outside the building. Although the additional charge does not apply in this case, reading those statements in the officers report will alert the Judge/Prosecutor to the enhanced seriousness of the offense. Further, in cases where there is a victim that was injured due to an intoxicated driver, maximum penalties are normally sought. If you, or a member of your staff, would like to be heard on this matter in court, I can make that request on your behalf to the prosecutor.
