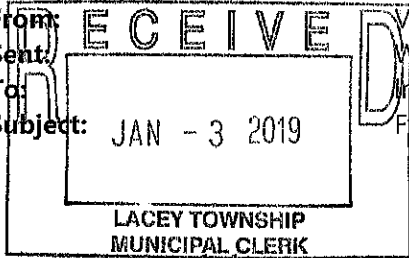

Dear Lacey Township,

This is a request for public records made under OPRA and the common law right of access. I am not required to fill out an official form. Please acknowledge receipt of this message.

Records requested:

For the purpose of this OPRA request, I am seeking documents pertaining to the Lacey Township Police Department response to the Home Depot Parking Lot on 1/2/2019 that resulted in the detainment of two subjects and a motor vehicle search at approximately 4 PM (the "incident").

Pursuant to Executive Order 69 (Whitman, 1997), I request the following regarding this incident:

- (a) where a crime has been reported but no arrest yet made, information as to the type of crime, time, location and type of weapon, if any;
- (b) if an arrest has been made, information as to the name, address and age of any victims, unless there has not been sufficient opportunity for notification of next of kin of any victims of injury and/or death to any such victim or where the release of the names of any victim would be contrary to existing law or court rule. In deciding on the release of information as to the identity of a victim, the safety of the victim and the victim's family, and the integrity of any ongoing investigation, shall be considered;
- (c) if an arrest has been made, information as to the defendant's name, age, residence, occupation, marital status and similar background information and the identity of the complaining party, unless the release of such information is contrary to existing law or court rule;
- (d) information as to the text of any charges, such as the complaint, accusation and indictment, unless sealed by the court or unless the release of such information is contrary to existing law or court rule;
- (e) information as to the identity of the investigating and arresting personnel and agency and the length of the investigation;
- (f) information of the circumstances immediately surrounding the arrest, including but not limited to the time and place of the arrest, resistance, if any, pursuit, possession and nature and use of weapons and ammunition by the suspect and by the police; and

(g) information as to circumstances surrounding bail, whether it was posted and amount thereof.

Please note that Executive Order 69 requires a response to this OPRA request within 24 hours.

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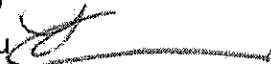

Media Release

On Wednesday, January 2, 2019, at 3:19 p.m., Officer Daniel Ricciardella responded to Lacey Shell, 922 Lacey Road, Forked River, for a report of a fraud/theft involving a subject passing a counterfeit \$100.00 bill. Officer Ricciardella met with an employee of Shell, who reported the \$100.00 bill had been used to purchase fuel. The bill was found to be counterfeit. A vehicle description was provided to Officer Ricciardella, and he provided the vehicle description over the radio. At the same time, Officer Michael Hein responded to Home Depot, 244 Route 9 N for an unrelated call for service. While on scene at the Home Depot, Officer Hein observed the suspect vehicle and conducted a motor vehicle stop in the Home Depot Parking lot. Officers Randolph Plis and Darrell Nick responded to assist Officer Hein with the motor vehicle stop.

During the motor vehicle stop multiple reports of fraud/theft were received from Medicine to Go 528 Lacey Road, the UPS Store and Hand and Stone located in Lacey Mall 344 Route 9 N, for counterfeit \$100.00 bills being used to make purchases in the stores. Similar descriptions of the suspects as well as the vehicle description were provided.

Investigation at the scene (Home Depot parking lot) yielded several other counterfeit \$100.00 bills as well as proceeds from the other establishments. The four occupants were identified as; 19-year-old Omari J. Kiser of 568 Central Ave, Brooklyn, NY, 23-year old Khalil T. Montez of 1266 E 85th Street, Brooklyn, NY, 25-year-old Sharnon Henry of 1706 Eastern Parkway, Brooklyn, NY and 26-year-old Quayshaun L. Mckinnonsmith of 250 Lott Avenue, Brooklyn, NY. They were all arrested and all charged with Theft by Deception, Forgery, Conspiracy as well as Possession of CDS. The driver, Quayshaun L. Mckinnonsmith was charged with motor vehicle charges for careless driving as well as CDS in a motor vehicle. All were transferred to Ocean County Jail in accordance with bail reform.
