Dear Mr. Gallo,

The Carteret Borough Hall received your OPRA Records Act (NJSA 47:1A-1) dated October 1, 2019. The official Records Custodian, Captain Michael Dammann received your OPRA request on October 2, 2019. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is October 11, 2019. This response is provided on the **Seventh (7th)** business day since the Carteret Police Department records custodian received a said request.

The following specific records have been requested:

"Please provide all incident reports or command incident reports in Carteret NJ, on 09/30/2019, between the hours of 0800-2200; (8 AM-10 PM) particularly, around the turnpike, and Exit 12 on the industrial road."

These records are criminal investigator records, and such are exempt from release under OPRA. Pursuant to NJSA 47:1A-1.1, criminal investigator records are "records which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file that are held by a law enforcement agency which pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding."

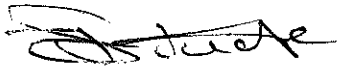
For those reason listed above your request is **denied**.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days by law, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Carteret Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint form.
