Good day,

The Ocean County Sheriff's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on or about December 18, 2021. The official Records Custodian, Lt. Adrian Bullock, received your OPRA request on December 20, 2021. Public Law 2020 c. 20 provides that during a period declared pursuant to the laws of this State as a state of emergency, public health emergency, or state of local disaster emergency, the deadlines by which to respond to a request for, or grant or deny access to, a government record under the Open Public Records Act shall not apply.

The following records were requested: "The following records are requested for an EMS response in Tuckerton Borough on December 17, 2021 involving a respiratory at 120 W Main St, Tuckerton Borough, at 10:32:55.

-All radio traffic between Ocean County dispatch and all EMS units assigned (including mutual aid) for the duration of the call. This includes response, arrival, special requests, transport, and clear/available radio traffic. (If other calls/radio traffic bleed over during this duration it is okay).

- Recording of all 911 calls pertaining to this incident

- CAD dispatch, response, arrival, and transport times with units assigned. Please include medic unit assigned with times if medic unit was requested.

- Any additional notes/reports pertaining to this incident."

The following is a line by line response to your requested items.

A. Requested records

I. CAD Call reports and Audio, notes regarding an EMS response in Tuckerton Borough on December 17, 2021 involving a respiratory at 120 W Main St, Tuckerton Borough, at 10:32:55.

This response is being communicated with you via e-mail as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Ocean County Sheriff's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. 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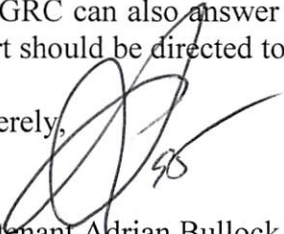
