On the above date and time I, Ptl. Christopher was notified by county dispatch via two way radio transmission to respond to an unconscious male in a vehicle at 228 Hancock Avenue. I notified dispatch that I was in route to the scene.

Upon arrival Ptl. Linnell was already on scene attempting to make a forced entry on the passenger side window of the vehicle. There were two dogs in the vehicle with the non responsive male. Ptl. Linnell was able to break through the window but one of the animals bit his right hand. Once the doors were unlocked I approached the driver side door and opened it to assess the subject.

I lifted his head off the steering wheel and attempted to check for a pulse on the side of the neck when one of the animals also bit my right hand,.

The Patient later identified as William Spencer was not breathing. Medics arrived on scene and moved the male out of the vehicle.

I began CPR.

Once more EMS arrived they took over CPR.

EMS was able to get a pulse and transported Mr. Williams to Community Medical Center. I transported the caller/wife Tracey Spencer to CMC and waited with her until her family arrived.

Mr. Williams is currently at Community Medical Center but still unresponsive. I contacted his wife 01/01/2024 at approximately 11:20 hours via phone to gather more info. She stated to me that Mr. Williams condition is not improving and will be taken off life support today.

On December 31, 2024 at approximately 13:25 hours I, Ptl. Christopher Linnell, responded to 228 Hancock Avenue in Seaside Heights, NJ 08751 for a report of an unconscious male, locked inside of a vehicle. Upon arrival to the address I located a female in the driveway of the residence next to a large black pick up truck. She informed me that her husband was in the drivers seat unconscious and that the doors were locked. I then approached the vehicle and double checked the door and did in fact find them to be locked. I also did in fact observe an unconscious male in the drivers seat and as well two dogs in the vehicle.

At this time I then forced entry into the vehicle by breaking the passenger side window. Upon doing so I stuck my hand inside the vehicle to unlock. While do so I was then bit on my left hand by one of the dogs that were in the vehicle, I was then able to get my hand back into the vehicle and then opened the door. At this time I then unlocked the driver side and ran to that side of the vehicle. Once there I opened the driver side door and checked for breathing and pulse on the male. I felt a very faint pulse, but observed that the male was not breathing.

At this time the patient was then removed from the vehicle and brought down onto the ground where live saving measures were then performed. During this time paramedics from Robert Wood Johnson arrived, along with members from Tri-Boro First and Lavallette First Aid Squads. As these members continued to treat the male I went and spoke with the caller. Upon doing so she identified the patient as William Spencer. She stated that he had went to the store to get sandwiches and she felt that he was gone for too long of a period of time. She stated that she began to call him multiple times but he did not answer the phone so she went outside to check and see if he was outside. She stated that she went outside and that is where she found him inside of the vehicle.

At this time I returned to the patient and was advised my medical personnel that they had gotten a heart beat back in Spencer but he was not yet breathing on his own. They had then gotten the patient into the ambulance and transported him to Community Medical Center where further treatment was sought.

The caller, Tracy Spencer, was transported to hospital by Ptl. Christopher in a Seaside Heights Police Department vehicle.

It was later learned that while at Community Medical Center during life saving measures William Spencer was stabilized and breathing via a ventilator. It was then later learned that on January 1, 2024 Spencer passed away.
