



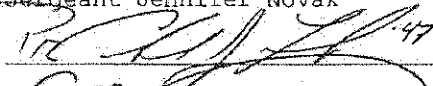

On Thursday November 29, 2018 at 1911 hours, I was dispatched to the South River Rescue Squad building (6 Thomas Street) on a report of a walk-in EMS call.

Upon arrival, I observed one of the EMT's just finishing rendering aid to a small child sitting on the lap of his mother. The EMT had placed a [REDACTED]. The child was identified as 1 year old [REDACTED]. According to his mother, identified as Gessika Rosa Basilio, A.B. had [REDACTED]. She further stated, not knowing what to do, she brought the child to the rescue squad building.

EMT's stated they could not transport Gessika and her child. It was explained to Gessika, EMS from Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital were being dispatched to transport her and A.B. to the hospital for further treatment. Gessika stated she wished to transport her child herself and not wait for the ambulance. She subsequently [REDACTED].
