SCENE INFORMATION AND RESPONSE

On 09/23/2017 at approximately 1250 hours, I, Detective Jillian Marin #185 arrived at Community Medical Center in Toms River, NJ to attend the post mortem examination of Michael Francis Flick DOB 02/15/45, SSN 145-32-4421.

The examination was conducted at Community Medical Center at the request of the Ocean County Medical Examiner's Office. The examination was conducted by Dr. Ragasa with the assistance of Erica Sorensen.

OBSERVATIONS

Upon my arrival, I observed a sealed white body containment bag with tag #1444714 sealed at 0640 hours on 09/23/17 by Detective O'Hearn. The decedent was observed to be a white male, 72 years of age with gray hair. The eyes were noted as blue in color. The decedent weighed approximately 154 pounds and measured approximately 65 inches in length.

The decedent was clothed in a black short sleeve T-shirt, blue jeans, brown belt, white socks and yellow boxer style underwear. I observed no medical equipment on the decedent. The decedent was observed to have a gunshot entrance wound on the left side of his head in the area of his temple. I observed a black ring around the edges of the wound. There was no exit wound observed.

Inked elimination prints were collected and submitted into evidence as well as a set of X-Rays of the decedent's head and fragments of projectile from the decedent's brain (see Lab Items #12-14).



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The cause of death was determined by Dr. Ragasa to be self-inflicted gunshot wound and the manner to be suicide. Examination concluded at 1455 hours.

I cleared from the scene at 1514 hours. No further CSI services were rendered in regards to the aforementioned incident at this time.
