On 05/17/2022 at approximately 14:39 hours, I responded to 1201 Route 37 E for a harassment report. Upon arrival, I made contact with victim Stacy L. Becker, who is an employee of Always Immaculate cleaning service.

Becker stated that she works in the office for Always Immaculate, and approximately a week ago, one of her workers damaged a customer's sink while cleaning their home. Becker stated that when she was notified of this, she hired a third party contractor to respond to the home to repair the damage. Becker stated that she found the contractor, All New Tub & Tile Refinishing & Repair, online, and chose them based on their above average online reviews. Becker stated that when she contacted the company originally, they sent a representative to the residence to provide an estimate for the work. Becker stated that the original estimate was based on approximately two hours of work.

Becker stated that on today's date, All New Tub & Tile Refinishing & Repair sent a repair technician to fix the damage on the sink. Becker stated that she was notified by the homeowner after the work was completed that it only took approximately 45 minutes to complete the work. Becker stated that due to this, she contacted the company to inquire about a lower price due to the job being completed in less time than originally estimated. Becker stated that she spoke with Russell Frontera, who represented the company. Becker stated that when she made her inquiry about the price for the work, she was met with anger and hostility from Frontera. Becker stated that after ending the phone conversation, she navigated to Google and left a 1 star review for the business due to the unprofessionalism of Frontera on the phone. Becker stated that once Frontera was made aware of this, he contacted her 10 times via email and 4 times via telephone. Becker stated that she eventually answered one of Frontera's calls and advised him to please stop contacting her and the business, which then prompted Frontera to send an email to Becker.

I then spoke with Frontera via telephone, who corroborated Becker's story regarding the work done on today's date. Frontera advised that due to the bad Google review, he was going to sue Becker for slander. Frontera was advised at this time to cease all contact with Becker and Always Immaculate. Becker was advised of complaint procedures. Nothing further.

On 07/01/2022, at approximately 02:37 hours, I was dispatched to 1799 Mt Everest Ln for a report of harassment. Upon arrival, I met with the victim,

James stated that he had recently been "friend requested" on Facebook by a person by the name of Breanna. stated that Breanna had sent him a link, via a Facebook Messenger, to "prove that he was a real person". stated that he followed the link and later found out that the link was created with the purpose to change his Facebook password. stated that shortly after the link was sent, he lost all control of his Facebook account. stated that he began to receive messages from Lisa Jones, who is like a daughter to advising him that she believed his account had been hacked. Lisa sent screenshots of a message thread between her and himself. stated that he did not send those messages and as time went on, it was made apparent that Breanna was attempting to ransom the account information to Lisa.

I then asked if he had sent any compromising photos, credit card information, or money in the form of gift cards, to which he stated that he did not. did state that Breanna had been asking for photos of him. stated that he sent a headshot of himself but affirmed that he never sent any compromising images of himself to Breanna. then stated that during their brief contact, Breanna had sent videos of herself dancing provocatively. was adamant that he never asked for those videos, nor did he reciprocate in anyway. went on to state that Breanna has not contacted him since his account had been hacked and that Lisa had been receiving messages containing threats to have arrested for rape if the ransom was not met. stated that Breanna has been trying to ransom his account information for \$50 but neither party had paid Breanna anything. went on to state that Breanna had made a wanted poster containing ' headshot and a naked male in a chastity belt, as a means to leverage Lisa. stated that the male depicted in the wanted photo headshot was him, but the man in chastity was not. stated that the woman he saw in the dancing videos appeared to a black or hispanic woman, in her late 20s, with long dark hair, but went on to state that he did not have any other information on Breanna.

I advised that he had been scammed via the link that had been sent to him and that Breanna was likely a scammer of unknown gender or ethnicity. I told him the photoshopped wanted poster did not show any compromising images of himself and that it was likely being used to illicit a ransom payment. was ultimately advised to contact Facebook support and attempt to have Breanna's account banned and to have his account restored. I also expressed to ; that if Lisa wanted a report for the ongoing harassment via Facebook Messenger, that she should contact her local law enforcement agency. was encouraged to block Breanna and to tell Lisa to do the same. The images of the screenshots

will be attached with this report. Nothing further.

On 10/24/22 at approximately 0222 hours, K9 Ptl. R. Buhowski #356 and I (Ptl. J. Pedalino #358) responded to the area of Santa Anita and McPherson for a welfare check. A concerned citizen heard yelling coming from outside her residence.

Upon arrival, Ptl. Buhowski located a vehicle parked, blocking in multiple cars, with no passenger side tires, damaged rims, and the vehicle disabled. The vehicle, a 2014 Dodge Ram Pickup bearing registration P38SNR, is registered to Nichole Fattorosi, who resides at 1002 Arlington Drive. There was blood on the exterior of the vehicle as well as inside the vehicle. We responded to the residence to make contact with registered owner.

I made contact with Junior Kennedy who stated that he was driving in Brick Township, when his vehicle struck the curb and damaged the tires. Mr. Kennedy believed that he could make it home and continued to drive. When he got to the area of his residence, he parked the truck in the street. Mr. Kennedy then went inside and struck a flat screen television on the bedroom wall. He damaged the television screen and sustained a laceration to his left hand, near the thumb. The wound was covered and still actively bleeding. He refused medical treatment on scene and was transported to Monmouth Medical South by his sister. Mr. Kennedy stated that he always drives the truck however it is registered to his girlfriend Nichole.

Due to the call of screaming, damage to vehicle, and large amount of blood inside the vehicle, we made contact with Mr. Kennedy and conducted a welfare check on Ms. Fattorosi. Ms. Fattorosi was staying at a family residence tonight due to a trip, at 1103 Winteringham Village. Ptl. Manolio and Ptl. K. O'Leary made contact with Ms. Fattorosi and she stated that she was fine, was not with Mr. Kennedy all night, that the vehicle is his, however it is registered in her name, and that there is no problem between the two individuals.

The vehicle in question was disabled in the roadway and was towed by Priced Rite Towing. A check of the area was met with negative results. Brick and Lakewood Police Department were notified of the incident and could not locate a crash scene. Nothing further.
