Narrative

On the above date and time, Ptl. Lauretta and I responded to [REDACTED] Shore Rd for a neighbor dispute over local zoning issues on the waterway.

On arrival, I spoke with Michael Dale of [REDACTED] Shore Rd, who stated that Keith Salnick of [REDACTED] Shore Rd was illegally parking his boat on Dale's dock. Michael Dale stated for the years 2015 and 2016, Salnick rented the dock to park his boat. Dale stated 2017 he stopped renting the dock due to neighbor issues.

Dale showed us the boat in question, which was indeed tied off on the dock. Dale showed patrol zoning plans and aerial views of the waterfront property. Dale described the property in between his and Salnick's property was his. After buying the property next door, the dock and water access came along with the purchase. One aspect of the Deed stated there was a 10 ft section of the waterway that was owned by Salnick.

Dale stated he is currently speaking with his lawyers and Salnick to try and settle the dispute.

Currently the Vessel, (4391 FN) appears to be unregistered in the waterway and was brought to Salnick's attention. Patrol advised Salnick of this and stated he will register it within a week. Patrol also asked Salnick to remove the boat from Dale's dock, in which it is tied down to. Salnick responded and said that his 10 ft waterway property is part of the dock and would not remove it.

Both parties claim property of the dock and will not compromise at this time. Patrol advised Salnick not to trespass on Dale's property and the only access currently lies on Dale's property and is posted no trespassing. Salnick advised he will take his smaller crab boat to access his boat that is tied to the dock.

Patrol contacted Carteret State Police Marine Division and advised them of the waterway issue. I spoke with Sgt. Jim Matier #6461, who advised he will speak with both parties on this issue. Currently the State Police Marine Division is investigating this issue.

I later received a call back from Sgt. Jim Matier who advised me that Salnick will be removing the boat from the dock and the neighbors will be resolving the issue in court. NFI

Narrative

On the above date and time, patrol responded to 60 Shore Rd for a report of excessively loud music coming from inside the home.

On arrival, patrol observed the residence to be fully lit with interior lights and all the windows open. The music was able to be heard from Gooseneck Point Road as we turned onto Shore Road.

Patrol walked onto the deck and announced our presence without a response. The music was so loud that it was useless to keep screaming to await a response due to the time of night. Patrol then circled the home on foot and looked through every window on the main floor. We were unable to locate the owner. Patrol did observe, several different shoes and shirts spread throughout the main floor from the screen door. To be noted, the sliding screen door was slightly ajar which appeared to be suspicious in nature, due to the time of night and having no response to verbal stimuli. Patrol used flashlights outside the home and shined them into each window to try and get a response. Patrol also looked around for anyone in the immediate area. This concluded negative results.

Patrol advised dispatch that we would be entering the home to attempt to locate the resident.

Patrol canvassed every room in the home to make sure everyone was safe in the home but it appeared that the residence was empty. While in the residence, the music was extremely loud and kept turning on and off. I observed a cell phone on the main floor, sitting on the couch and checked to see if the phone was playing the music through Bluetooth in an attempt to turn off the music. The phone was not playing the music.

To be noted, once the music turned off, officers announced their presence in an attempt to alert the resident.

Patrol was exiting the residence and a subject was standing at the sliding screen door using his cell phone to record officers. The subject was identified as Keith Salnick of 60 Shore Road. He asked patrol why we were inside of his home without a warrant and continued to record. He was advised his music was extremely to loud and due to the circumstances officers checked the home for any suspicious activity and to make sure any and all residents were safe.

Salnick was issued a noise ordinance ticket for the music that was echoing outside his property line.

To be noted, it appeared that Salnick was wet and wearing a robe as he was recording officers inside his home. It also appeared that Salnick was extremely intoxicated while speaking to officers. The odor an alcoholic beverage was emanating from his breath during a brief discussion. Patrol cleared without any further issues. NFI
