Narrative

On the above date and time I, Ofcr. Petrillo, responded to the residence at [REDACTED] Shore Road for an on-going neighbor dispute. (17OP02738) This dispute centers around differing views of property lines as it pertains to waterway access. On arrival I was greeted by the complainant, Mr. Michael Dale, on the front lawn. Mr. Dale provided me with a copy of a property survey which Mr. Dales believes to show the area in question. According to Mr. Dale upon his acquisition of Lot # 29, adjacent to his property on the eastern side, a ten foot right of way was created to enable waterway access. Mr. Dale believes this right of way should be measured from a property marker stone located between Shore Rd and the water line on the SE corner of Lot # 29. Mr. Dale stated he had been in contact with numerous lawyers about the issue and wished for work to stop as he felt it was being conducted outside the allowed right of way. Mr. Dale went on to add that he had spoken with the Department of Environmental Protection and was told his window to object to the plans and building had expired.

I then moved to the site of the on-going dock building construction by Twin Rivers Marine Construction. On site was the resident of 60 Shore Rd, Mr. Keith Salnick who commissioned the dock building project. Mr. Salnick provided NJDEP building plans for the dock currently being built at that location. The permit was stamped and sealed as approve, bearing permit number 1338-17-0004.1 approved on 16JAN18. Mr. Salnick described a tenuous relationship between him and Mr. Dale since he moved next door. He's view of the right of way for construction differed from that of Mr. Dale and his workers were moving ahead with the approved plans.

At that time I moved to my patrol vehicle and placed a call to the Oceanport Building and Zoning office and left a message requesting to speak with the engineer or technical assistant. With the assistance of Sgt. Tucci a short time later the Borough Engineer, Mr. Bill White, arrived on site to inspect the situation. As the construction did not require Borough Permits due to the waterfront easement Mr. White stated the matter was a civil one between neighbors and in the hands of the State of New Jersey.

I informed both parties of the outcome and informed them to consult their lawyers to address the matter. NFA

Narrative

On the above date and time I, Ofcr. Petrillo, was advised that Bill White, the Borough Engineer, was at Oceanport Police Headquarters wishing to make a report. I ushered Mr. White inside and asked the reasons for his visit. At that time Mr. White related the following events.

On the afternoon of 09MAY18 Mr. White was requested by a representative of the NJDEP to respond to the area of 60 Shore Dr. The NJDEP agent requested his assistance regarding an ongoing property dispute. While working with the NJEP agent Mr. White stated that Mr. Keith Salnick of 60 Shore Rd confronted him about meeting. Mr. White informed Mr. Salnick that he would call him on 10MAY18 as he was currently engaged and had a follow on appointment upon completion. Mr. Salnick departed upon hearing this but returned a short time later again asking to meet with Mr. White. Mr. Salnick received the same response.

Upon returning home on the night of 09MAY18 Mr. White stated that Mr. Salnick came to his residence to confront him about meeting. During this exchange Mr. White stated that Mr. Salnick use profane language which upset his wife. Mr. White wished for the incident to be documented due to his erratic behavior in the past.

I provided Mr. White with the Department Complaint Statement form and asked him to complete it. Mr. White asked if he could complete it at home and return it at a later time. I placed the case number on the form and advised that he could return it anytime, preferably during business hours. He thanked me and departed. Nothing further pending receipt of his complaint statements.

Narrative

On the above date and time I, Ofcr. Petrillo, observed a dog running loose in the area of Monmouth Blvd between Milton and Arnold Ave. I moved to that area and attempted to apprehend the animal. After pursuing the animal through a few yards on Driveway, I was able to restrain it at Charles Park. The animal was predominately brown with gray specks and spots, wiry short hair, long ears, and a short tail. At that time I saw the dog had a tag identifying it as Clyde along with its home at 60 Shore Rd and a phone number. A call the number went unanswered. At that time I loaded the animal into my vehicle and transported it home. Prior to arrival I began a Borough Ordinance Violation for the offense.

On arrival at 60 Shore Rd I found Mr. Keith Salnick mowing the front yard. I turned over the animal to him, established him as the owner, and obtained his license to complete the citation. During that time Mr. Salnick made comments about how he pays taxes and feels as though that's enough and should not be issued a ticket. He made further comments implying the Police are carrying out a vendetta against him imposed by the Mayor and Council. I informed Mr. Salnick that if this had been his first offense he would have received a warning like everyone else. He was provided his copy of the citation at which time I departed. NFA
