Narrative

On the above date and time, William White III responded to police headquarters to report that he is being harassed by a resident in town regarding an ongoing construction project.

White advised that he is an engineer for Maser Consulting, an engineering firm contracted by the Borough Of Oceanport. They are currently overlooking a project that is installing new drainage, regrading the roadway and installing curbing on the streets of Gooseneck Pt Rd and Shore Rd. White explained that the resident off 60 Shore Rd recently requested to have a conduit put under the roadway to his dock across the river. This request was reportedly denied. The land which Salnick's dock is on is reportedly no owned by Salnick. Due to this, the property owner requested the curb not be depressed. Salnick then broke the newly installed curb and was charged with Criminal Mischief (see 22OP14198).

White explained that he was meeting with engineering inspector Wes Whalen on Gooseneck Pt Rd when Salnick approached him and asked about the curbing. White explained to Salnick that he would need to look into it and get back to him. White then responded to Borough Hall to speak with the borough Clerk and the Borough Administrator. White explained that Salnick followed him to Borough Hall and began to yell at White. White explained that when he was inside the building, Salnick was knocking on the window and yelling at him from the outside. Salnick also advised White that he would call all of White's bosses and get him fired. White advised that Salnick has already called the owner of White's company's secretary. I advised White that incidents over the phone should be reported to Middletown PD, where the office is located.

White also advised that he has had similar harassment reports regarding Salnick in the past. See 18OP04014.

I advised White that if he wished to press charges against Salnick, he would need to do so at our Municipal Court. White explained that he only wanted this incident documented. White filled out a statement of information form. White was given the case number and explained the process in which to pick up this report. Nothing further at this time. Patrol clear.

Keith Salnick responded to police headquarters to speak with me in reference to a Special Complaint summons he was recently issued. See 22OP14198. I met with Keith. We then spoke in the police department lobby.

Salnick voiced his disagreement with the summons. Salnick explained that he was instructed by the foreman and the workers on scene that he could break the curb as the concrete was not hardened. Salnick also advised that this instruction came from the job site foreman Paul Ralph. Salnick continued that he feels he is being harassed by different members of the borough, specifically the engineer and "other people that are making decisions". Salnick then played a voice recording of conversation he had with worker. The worker explains that the crew originally made a depressed curb, when a neighbor who claimed to own the property behind the curb requested it not be depressed. The crew then added curbing to the depressed curb at the neighbors request. In the recording, the worker also advised the following: "Cause I know, Me and Luis. When all that stuff happened over here, we were on the other side working over here. So we honestly don't know what the hell happened. We didn't really see shit". The unknown worker continues that he does not agree with the summons that Salnick was issued. Salnick advised that he feels the borough is leveraging the police against him. He then advises that he was handed a pick axe by the workers. Salnick then inquired about signing complaints against his neighbor. He was referred to the Oceanport Municipal Court. He then later acknowledges that the curb belongs to the borough of Oceanport. He was then given OPRA forms and sent on his way.

Narrative

At the above date and time I, SLEOII Peacock IV #704 responded to 60 Shore Rd. for a caller reporting a parking violation. Upon arrival I observed a fishing boat on a trailer parked on the side of the road, against the curb, and unhooked to any vehicle in front of 60 Shore Rd. I attempted to make contact of the owner and spoke to the attached individual, Keith Salnick.

I notified him that the boat is taking up a lot of space in the roadway causing vehicles to have to squeeze around. I also stated that there is not enough room for emergency vehicles, such as firetrucks and ambulances to get around.

I educated him of Borough Code 390-22 (Off-street Parking) and how he is in violation for having his boat stored in the roadway. Keith stated he is not storing the boat there, he is repairing it. I advised him that the Brough Code also states it can not be on the roadway for repairs either.

Narrative

On the above date and time, I, Ptl. Daniel Petrucelli was dispatched to Borough Hall to take a report from the Borough Clerk Jeanne Smith.

I arrived and turned on my body camera. I entered Mrs. Smith's office.

She advised me that she wanted to document an incident that has happened over the last few days. It started on Thursday March 23rd, 2023. She advised Mr. Keith Salnick entered borough hall to turn in his application/ petition for the upcoming election in November. He also turned in a form with signatures as required to Mrs. Smith.

Smith informed him that his application had to be resubmitted as the application also contained a name for council. Each person was required to submit independent applications. They spoke about the signature sheet and Smith advised him that she would look at the form but could not certify it as the process was not complete until after Monday.

On Friday March 24th, 2023, Salnick returned with the updated application. Smith reported to Salnick that at this time he had 24 valid signatures. She advised him if other applicants had the same names then those names would be disqualified. Salnick advised her he would get more signatures to insure he made the required amount to make the ballot. He asked for the application back and she stated she could not give it back but would send him a scan of the application for his records.

Smith later emailed same to Salnick.

Smith reported over the weekend Salnick sent her numerous emails accusing her of not doing her job and not sending him the information he had requested. See attached emails for further information.

Smith spoke with the Borough attorney on Monday morning under attorney client privilege to discuss how to respond to the allegations. Smith sent a return email on Monday discussing the allegations Salnick was making.

At approximately 1450 on Monday March 27th, Salnick came to Borough Hall to drop off his additional signatures. At this time, he was buzzed into the building and began to speak with Kim Parent at the window. Parent advised Salnick that Smith was not available and was unable to take the form. Salnick observed Smith working inside her office and began to yell her name slapping the paperwork on the window in the common hallway to get her attention. Parent again advised him she was busy and not available to speak with him at that time. Salncik then entered a closed door leading to the rear area of the offices. He walked to Smith's office door and stood in the doorway. Smith stated she felt cornered in her office and began to tell him to get out. After telling him a few times to exit the office area and return to the common hallway Salnick returned to the glass window in the hallway. Parent was then instructed by Smith to take the form from Salnick. He then left the building.

Smith advised she has had other problems with Salnick in the past over OPRA request and Zoning issues within the borough. She asked that this incident be documented because Salnick is a current Councilman in town. She stated she would be following up with the Mayor and Borough administrator about her concerns about harassment in the workplace.

I then spoke with Kim Parent. She advised that Salnick came in on Monday. She told Salnick at Smith was not available and that she couldn't take the form. He became upset and began to yell and hit the window with the paperwork. He then walked down the common hallway toward the construction office. A short time later, Salnick entered the door to the rear area and walked into Smith's doorway. Smith yelled at him numerous times to leave that area. She was then instructed to take the form from Salnick which she did. He then left.

I provided Smith and Parent with Oceanport Police statement forms and requested they give written statements which they both agreed to.

Later in the day, I received Parent's statement.
