Chief's Narrative

Incident #: 21-1172

Location: 31 Bay Way, Brick, NJ 08723

District one was called to the address above for a working structure fire. After the dispatch went out 2210 signed on and headquarters confirmed heavy smoke and fire. While responding, 2210 called for a second and third alarm, due to the updates received by headquarters.

Upon arrival, 2210 confirmed there was heavy fire from the Division B side of the structure with a second structure starting to catch fire, 29 Bay Way, and established command. Shortly after arrival 2210 was advised that there was natural gas leaking and it was fueling the fire along with the heavy wind condition. The neighboring houses in the area were evacuated by Brick Township Police.

2241 was the first engine on scene and was ordered to hit the hydrant and start flowing water on the main body of fire with their deck gun and 2 ½ in blitz fire on Division A. At the 10-minute timer there was heavy fire that was gas feed with both structures fully involved. As more units arrived, they were put to work assisting 2241. 2305 was set up on the corner of Blue Cedar and Bay Way (Division A) and went into aerial operations and started to flow water from their bucket to work on the main body of fire. 2101 went into operations in Division A of the structure with hand line and blitz fire gun. 2931 went into operations with hand lines. 2115 was set up at the corner of Lawndale and Bay Way and went into aerial operations flowing water to the Division D side of 31 Bay Way to work on the main fire and to protect the Division B side of 35 Bay Way. Water units 2906 and 2756 were in the rear of the structure (Division C) to work on the fire. Both boats were flowing water for suppression. Crews from 2241 and Station 23 were able to gain access into the secondary structure, 29 Bay Way, and worked on interior suppression. When the structure started to become compromised, the Evacuation Alarms were sounded, all firefighters exited the building and a PAR was taken. All firefighters were accounted for.

The fire was under control at 17:27 and overhaul operations started.

There was one reported injury to Firefighter [redacted] he was treated on scene and released for a small burn to the back of his neck. Firefighter [redacted] was on Division 2 for the secondary structure, 29 Bay Way, when the ceiling collapsed and an ember went in between he hood and the collar of his jacket.

New Jersey Natural Gas, Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority and Jersey Central Power & Light were all notified to secure the utilities.
