On the above date, I was traveling through the parking lot for the Red Bank Train Station on the east side.

While driving through the lot, I heard glass breaking coming from the platform area of the station. Due to this, I exited my patrol vehicle to attempt to find the source. Once out of my vehicle, I was able to observe a male subject who had jumped off of the platform and was currently on the NJ Transit train tracks breaking glass bottles.

I radioed this information to dispatch so that they could hold any incoming trains and made my way onto the platform. Once getting onto the platform, the male subject climbed off of the tracks and onto the platform where I was standing. I immediately recognized the male as Nihjer Hill whom I've dealt with on multiple prior occasions.

At this time, I placed Hill under arrest for defiant trespass due to being on the NJ Transit train tracks. Hill was transported to police headquarters where he was processed and issued summons 1340-S21-2021-000018 for 2C:18-3b. Hill was later released from custody without incident.

On Saturday April 11, 2021 at approximately 2221 hours was on patrol in the area of the Red Bank Train Station.

It should be noted I was wearing the Red Bank Police Class B Uniform and assigned to an unmarked patrol vehicle with my partner K-9 Hunter. It should also be noted that K-9 Hunter is a certified patrol and narcotics detection K-9.

While on patrol, I observed 2 individuals (known to me from prior police contact as Nina Ferrante of [REDACTED] and Thomas Armstrong of [REDACTED] walking from the rear of a dark alley located West of North of the Border Restaurant (176 Monmouth Street Red Bank New Jersey).

It should be noted that the area where Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong were walking from was dark, restaurant private property, and was not normal for the general public to be in that area.

I observed Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong walking South through the Red Bank Train Station parking lot. Thomas Armstrong continuously was looking backward over his shoulder.

I then observed Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong walk South across Chestnut street then walk South on the tracks near the railroad track crossing.

It should be noted that the area near the New Jersey Transit Rails is New Jersey Transit Property, poorly lit, and dangerous due to trains utilizing the rail lines.

In an effort to locate Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong, I traveled to an entryway south of Chestnut Street and drove North on New Jersey Transit Property.

I observed Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong walking south next to the railroad tracks on New Jersey Transit Property.

For my safety, I ordered Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong to place their hands on a nearby concrete base. Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong complied without incident.

Ptl. Doremus #233 soon arrived on scene to assist.

I advised Nina Ferrante and Thomas Armstrong they were being stopped for Defiant Trespass on New Jersey Transit Property.

Thomas Armstrong stated that he and Nina Ferrante were traveling from an unknown location to
